**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act relating to child development home provider  
2 qualifications.  
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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HF 2048

1 Section 1. Section 237A.3A, subsection 3, Code Supplement  
2 2003, is amended by adding the following new paragraph:

3 NEW PARAGRAPH. d. The standards for provider  
4 qualifications under category "C" which are applicable at  
5 times when more than one qualified provider must be present  
6 shall require one of the providers to meet the provider  
7 qualifications for category "C" and allow any other providers  
8 required to be present to meet the provider qualifications for  
9 either category "B" or "C".

10 EXPLANATION

11 This bill relates to the standards for child development  
12 home provider qualifications adopted as rules by the  
13 department of human services.

14 Under current law, the department standards for the child  
15 development homes are required to utilize three categories  
16 ("A", "B", and "C") ranked from least stringent to most  
17 stringent. The bill applies to the standards for provider  
18 qualifications in category "C" when more than one provider is  
19 required to be present. The bill provides that one of the  
20 providers present must meet the provider qualifications for  
21 category "C", but other providers required to be present shall  
22 be allowed to meet the provider qualifications for either  
23 category "B" or "C".

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
