Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 724.31 TRANSFER OF FIREARMS
 2 BETWEEN UNLICENSED PERSONS.

3 1. The private sale, lease, or other transfer of firearms 4 between two or more unlicensed persons shall be conducted 5 through a federally licensed firearm dealer and shall comply 6 with all applicable federal and state laws. The dealer may 7 charge a transfer fee not to exceed ten dollars. This 8 subsection does not apply to the sale, lease, or other 9 transfer of firearms in any of the following situations: 10 The person transferring the firearm or the person a. ll acquiring the firearm is a licensed firearm dealer under 12 federal law.

b. The firearm acquired is an antique firearm, a collector's item, a device which is not designed or redesigned for use as a firearm, a device which is designed solely for use as a signaling, pyrotechnic, line-throwing, safety, or similar device, or a firearm which is unserviceable by reason of being unable to discharge a shot by means of an explosive and is incapable of being readily restored to a firing condition.

21 c. The person acquiring the firearm is authorized to do so
22 on behalf of a law enforcement agency.

23 d. The person transferring the firearm and the person 24 acquiring the firearm are related to one another within the 25 second degree of consanguinity or affinity, unless the person 26 transferring the firearm knows that the person acquiring the 27 firearm would be ineligible to obtain a firearm under federal 28 or state law.

29 2. An unlicensed person who sells, leases, or transfers a 30 firearm to another unlicensed person, or an unlicensed person 31 who acquires a firearm from another unlicensed person, without 32 the sale, lease, or transfer conducted by a federally licensed 33 firearm dealer, commits an aggravated misdemeanor.

34 3. A person who sells, leases, or transfers a firearm to 35 another person, who the transferor knows or has reason to know

1 is prohibited from possessing firearms under federal or state
2 law, commits a class "D" felony.

EXPLANATION

4 This bill creates new Code section 724.31, relating to the 5 sale of firearms between unlicensed persons and providing 6 penalties.

The bill provides that a private sale, lease, or other 7 8 transfer of firearms between two or more persons shall be 9 conducted through a federally licensed firearm dealer. The 10 bill specifically excludes transfers of firearms between 11 persons where one person is a federally licensed firearm 12 dealer, transfers of firearms to persons authorized to do so 13 on behalf of a law enforcement agency, and transfers of 14 firearms between relatives, unless the relative transferring 15 the firearm knows or has reason to know the person to whom the 16 transfer is made would be ineligible to obtain a firearm under 17 state or federal law. The bill further excludes antique 18 firearms, collector's items, a device not designed or 19 redesigned for use as a firearm, a device designed solely for 20 use as a signaling, pyrotechnic, line-throwing, safety, or 21 similar device, or a firearm which is unserviceable. The bill further provides that an unlicensed person who 22 23 sells, leases, or transfers a firearm to another unlicensed 24 person, or an unlicensed person who acquires a firearm from 25 another unlicensed person, without going through a federally 26 licensed firearm dealer commits an aggravated misdemeanor. An 27 aggravated misdemeanor is punishable by confinement for no 28 more than two years and a fine of at least \$500 but not more 29 than \$5,000. A person who sells, leases, or transfers a 30 firearm to another individual who the transferor knows or has 31 reason to know is prohibited from possessing firearms commits 32 a class "D" felony. A class "D" felony is punishable by 33 confinement for no more than five years and a fine of at least 34 \$750 but not more than \$7,500.
