A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the allocation of motor vehicle use tax
2 revenues and creating an Iowa state patrol fund.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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HF 2100

1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 80.41 IOWA STATE PATROL FUND.

2 1. An Iowa state patrol fund is created as a separate fund
3 in the state treasury under the control of the department of
4 revenue. Notwithstanding section 12C.7, subsection 2,
5 interest and other moneys earned by the fund shall be
6 deposited in the fund. The fund shall include moneys credited
7 from the use tax as allocated under section 423.43, subsection
8 2.

9 2. Moneys credited to the fund shall be expended, pursuant
10 to appropriations made from the fund by the general assembly,
11 by the division of the Iowa state patrol of the department of
12 public safety for salaries, including salary adjustment
13 moneys, support, maintenance, and miscellaneous purposes,
14 including workers' compensation expenses and the state's
15 contribution to the peace officers' retirement, accident, and
16 disability system provided in chapter 97A.

17 3. Notwithstanding section 8.33, moneys credited to the
18 fund which remain unobligated or unexpended at the close of a
19 fiscal year shall not revert to the general fund of the state
20 but shall be credited to the Iowa state patrol fund.

21 Sec. 2. Section 423.43, subsection 2, as enacted by 2003
22 Iowa Acts, First Extraordinary Session, chapter 2, section
23 136, is amended to read as follows:

24 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of this section
25 that provides that all revenue derived from the use tax on
26 motor vehicles, trailers, and motor vehicle accessories and
27 equipment as collected pursuant to section 423.26 shall be
28 deposited and credited to the road use tax fund, twenty
29 percent of the revenues shall be credited and deposited as
30 follows: one-half to the road use tax fund and one-half to
31 the primary road fund to be used for the commercial and
32 industrial highway network, except to the extent that the
33 department directs that moneys are deposited in the Iowa state
34 patrol fund created in section 80.41 to fund the
35 appropriations made from the Iowa state patrol fund in

1 accordance with section 80.41. The department shall determine
2 the amount of moneys to be credited under this subsection to
3 the Iowa state patrol fund and shall deposit that amount into
4 the Iowa state patrol fund.

5 EXPLANATION

6 This bill creates an Iowa state patrol fund in the state
7 treasury under the control of the department of revenue.
8 Moneys in the fund are to be spent by the Iowa state patrol
9 division of the department of public safety for salaries,
10 workers' compensation expenses, and the state's contribution
11 to the peace officers' retirement, accident, and disability
12 system, subject to appropriation by the general assembly.
13 The bill provides that in order to fund appropriations from
14 the Iowa state patrol fund, the department of revenue may
15 direct that moneys from the portion of use taxes collected on
16 motor vehicles, trailers, and motor vehicle accessories and
17 allocated for the commercial and industrial highway network be
18 deposited into the Iowa state patrol fund.

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
