- 2 1. The commission or the director may issue any order
- 3 necessary to secure compliance with or prevent a violation of

- 24 with or prevent a violation of a provision of Code chapter
- 25 455C or a rule adopted pursuant to Code chapter 455C. The
- 26 bill requires the attorney general, upon request by the
- 27 department, to institute any civil or criminal legal
- 28 proceeding necessary to obtain compliance with an order of the
- 29 commission or director or to prosecute a person for a
