EXPLANATION This bill repeals the Iowa English Language Reaffirmation 5 Act, which provides that English is the state's official 6 language and prescribes the use of English by the state and 7 its political subdivisions. The bill also repeals a provision 8 governing rules of statutory construction for the state's 9 English language laws.
