Section 1. EQUALITY IN THE COURTS COMMISSION. 1 The 2 executive director of the commission on the status of women 3 shall convene a commission to review the implementation of 4 recommendations made by the Iowa supreme court's equality in 5 the courts task force. The membership of the commission shall 6 include the executive director of the commission on the status 7 of women, the state court administrator, one member appointed 8 by the Iowa judge's association, one member appointed by the 9 county attorney's association, one member appointed by the 10 dean of the university of Iowa college of law, one member 11 appointed by the dean of the Drake university law school, one 12 member representing defense attorneys appointed by a statewide 13 association representing defense attorneys, one member 14 appointed by a statewide victims' group, and the director of 15 the department of human rights or the directors' designee. 16 The commission shall report its findings and recommendations 17 to the general assembly on or before December 15, 2004. 18 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of 19 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment. 20 EXPLANATION This bill directs the executive director of the commission 21 22 on the status of women to convene a commission to review the 23 implementation of the recommendations made by the Iowa supreme 24 court's equality in the courts task force.
