1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 18A.6B STATE CAPITOL -- OPEN TO
2 PUBLIC.

3 The state capitol shall be open to the public from seven 4 a.m. to six p.m., on all days other than state holidays 5 enumerated in section IC.2. For purposes of this section, 6 "open to the public" means that members of the public, or 7 their belongings, shall not be subject to search or to 8 scanning by metal detectors or x-ray machines as a condition 9 of entering the state capitol. This section shall not 10 prohibit a person entering the state capitol or within the 11 state capitol from being subject to an otherwise lawful 12 search.

EXPLANATION

14 This bill provides that the state capitol shall be open to 15 the public seven days a week from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m., except on 16 state holidays. The bill defines "open to the public" to mean 17 that members of the public and their belongings shall not be 18 subject to search or scanning by metal detectors or x-ray 19 machines as a condition of entering the state capitol.
