Section 1. Section 481A.38, subsection 1, unnumbered
 2 paragraph 2, Code 2003, is amended to read as follows:
         The commission shall adopt a rule permitting a crossbow
 4 to be used only by individuals with disabilities who are
 5 physically incapable of using a bow and arrow under the
 6 conditions in which a bow and arrow is permitted.
7 commission shall prepare an application to be used by an
8 individual requesting the status. The application shall
9 require the individual's physician to sign a statement
10 declaring that the individual is not physically able to use a
11 bow and arrow.

     b. The commission shall adopt a rule permitting a crossbow

26 be used by persons requesting permission to use a crossbow to
27 hunt deer and require the applicant to produce proof of the
28 applicant's age.
      A violation of the provisions of the bill is punishable by
