- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 25B.8 REDUCTION IN FUNDING FOR 2 PROPERTY TAX CREDITS.
- 3 l. This section applies to the following appropriations
- 4 made for fiscal years beginning on or after July 1, 2004:
- 5 a. The standing unlimited appropriation made in section
- 6 425.1 for reimbursement for homestead property tax credits.
- 7 b. The standing unlimited appropriation made in section
- 8 425.39 for reimbursement for elderly and disabled property tax
- 9 credits.
- 10 c. The standing unlimited appropriation made in section
- 11 426A.1A for reimbursement for military service tax credits and
- 12 exemptions to the extent of six dollars and ninety-two cents
- 13 per one thousand dollars of assessed value of the exempt
- 14 property.
- 15 2. In order for the general assembly to reduce for the
- 16 fiscal year beginning the following July 1 any appropriation
- 17 specified in subsection 1, the bill which reduces that
- 18 appropriation shall be enacted by February 15 preceding the
- 19 fiscal year for which the appropriation is made.
- 20 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE AND APPLICABILITY DATES. This Act,
- 21 being deemed of immediate importance, takes effect upon
- 22 enactment and applies to appropriations made for fiscal years
- 23 beginning on or after July 1, 2004.
- 24 EXPLANATION
- 25 This bill requires that in order for certain standing
- 26 appropriations made for property tax reimbursement to be
- 27 reduced for the following fiscal year, the bill reducing the
- 28 appropriation shall be enacted prior to February 15 preceding
- 29 that fiscal year.
- 30 The standing appropriations covered by this bill are the
- 31 homestead, elderly and disabled, and military service property
- 32 tax credit reimbursements.
- 33 The bill takes effect upon enactment and applies to
- 34 appropriations made for fiscal years beginning on or after
- 35 July 1, 2004.
