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Section 1. Section 21.5, subsection 1, Code 2003, is

                             EXPLANATION
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      Code chapter 21, the open meetings law, allows a
13 governmental body to hold a closed session, pursuant to a two-
14 thirds vote, for a series of reasons. The bill allows a
15 meeting of a city or county governmental body to be closed to
16 discuss and negotiate certain economic development projects.
      Code section 22.7, subsection 8, allows Iowa department of
17
18 economic development information on an industrial prospect to
19 be closed to public inspection. The bill expands this
20 provision to include information concerning a business as well
21 as an industrial prospect and to make the exemption applicable
22 to a city or county as well as to the department of economic
23 development.
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
