1 Section 1. ADMINISTRATIVE RULES FOR FUGITIVE DUST. The  
2 department of natural resources shall amend 567 Iowa  
3 administrative code, rule 23.3, subrule 2, paragraph "c",  
4 subparagraph (1), to except grain elevator operations from the  
5 requirements of that provision regarding precautions to be  
6 taken to control the movement of fugitive dust.

7 EXPLANATION

8 This bill relates to air quality-related administrative  
9 rules adopted by the department of natural resources.  
10 Currently, the rules require certain precautions to be taken  
11 to control the movement of fugitive dust. Exceptions are  
12 provided for farming operations and dust generated by ordinary  
13 travel on unpaved public roads. The bill requires the  
14 department to add grain elevator operations to the list of  
15 exceptions for which certain precautions do not have to be  
16 taken.
