- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 613B.1 APPLICABILITY.
- Except as provided in subsection 2, this chapter
- 3 applies to an award of attorney fees in a class action
- 4 lawsuit, notwithstanding any of the following:
- 5 a. An agreement between the attorney for the class and any
- 6 member of the class.
- 7 b. Any other law or rule of court.
- 8 2. This chapter shall not apply to fees payable to the
- 9 attorney by a named plaintiff client out of the client's
- 10 funds, including the client's share of the common fund
- 11 recovered for the class, under an agreement between the
- 12 attorney and the client.

- 24 1. In a class action in which an award of attorney fees is
- 25 to be made, the court shall first determine the base fee under

- 27 2. In determining the amount of the attorney fees, the
- 28 court shall consider all of the following factors:
- 29 a. The number of hours reasonably expended by the attorney
- 30 for the class.
- 31 b. The hourly rate most appropriate for the services

- 35 This bill relates to the award of attorney fees in a class

1 action lawsuit. The bill applies to an award of attorney fees in a class 3 action to the attorney for the class, and such a fee must be 4 awarded out of a common fund or measured by a common benefit 5 recovered for the class. The bill does not apply to attorney 6 fees payable to the attorney by a named plaintiff client out 7 of the client's funds. The bill provides that the court shall award attorney fees 9 using a base fee, which is calculated on the number of hours 10 reasonably expended by the attorney multiplied by the hourly 11 rate most appropriate for the services provided by the 12 attorney. In determining the hourly rate, the court shall 13 consider and shall not exceed rates customarily charged in the 14 locality for similar legal services in an action other than a 15 class action. In addition, the bill provides that the court 16 may increase or decrease the base fee upon consideration of 17 the novelty and the difficulty of the issues involved in the 18 action, the skill required, the amount of money involved and 19 the results obtained, the time limitations imposed, and the 20 experience, reputation, and the ability of the attorney for The total fees awarded by the court shall not 21 the class. 22 exceed 25 percent of the common fund or common benefit 23 recovered for the class or four times the base fee, whichever 24 is less. The bill provides that the court may award the attorney 25 26 representing the class all reasonable expenses and costs of 27 litigation incurred by the attorney on behalf of the class. 28 29 30 31 32 33 34
