- 1 Section 1. Section 35A.11, Code 2003, is amended to read
- 2 as follows:
- 3 35A.11 VETERANS LICENSE FEE FUND.
- 4 A veterans license fee fund is created in the state
- 5 treasury under the control of the commission. The fund shall
- 6 include the fees credited by the treasurer of state from the
- 7 sale of special veteran license motor vehicle registration
- 8 plates pursuant to section 321.34, subsection 13, paragraph
- 9 "d", special Pearl Harbor registration plates pursuant to
- 10 section 321.34, subsection 17, and special United States armed
- 11 forces retired registration plates pursuant to section 321.34,
- 12 subsection 19. Notwithstanding section 12C.7, interest or
- 13 earnings on moneys in the veterans license fee fund shall be
- 14 credited to the veterans license fee fund. Moneys in the fund
- 15 are appropriated to the commission to be used to fulfill the
- 16 responsibilities of the commission.
- 17 Sec. 2. Section 321.34, subsections 17 and 19, Code
- 18 Supplement 2003, are amended to read as follows:
- 19 17. PEARL HARBOR SPECIAL PLATES.
- 20 a. An owner referred to in subsection 12 who was at Pearl
- 21 Harbor, Hawaii, as a member of the armed services of the
- 22 United States on December 7, 1941, may, upon written
- 23 application to the department, order special registration
- 24 plates with a Pearl Harbor processed emblem. The emblem shall
- 25 be designed by the department in consultation with service
- 26 organizations. The application is subject to approval by the
- 27 department.
- 28 b. The special fees collected pursuant to subsection 12
- 29 for issuance and annual validation of the special registration
- 30 plates issued under this subsection shall be paid monthly to
- 31 the treasurer of state and credited to the road use tax fund.
- 32 Notwithstanding section 423.24 and prior to the crediting of
- 33 the revenues to the road use tax fund under section 423.24,
- 34 subsection 1, paragraph "b", the treasurer of state shall
- 35 credit monthly to the veterans license fee fund under section

- 1 35A.11 the amount of the special fees collected in the
- 2 previous month for the Pearl Harbor plates.
- 3 19. UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES RETIRED SPECIAL PLATES.
- 4 a. An owner referred to in subsection 12 who is a retired
- 5 member of the United States armed forces may, upon written
- 6 application to the department and upon presentation of
- 7 satisfactory proof of membership, order special registration
- 8 plates with a United States armed forces retired processed
- 9 emblem. The emblem shall be designed by the department in
- 10 consultation with service organizations. The application is
- 11 subject to approval by the department. For purposes of this
- 12 subsection, a person is considered to be retired if the person
- 13 is recognized by the United States armed forces as retired
- 14 from the United States armed forces.
- b. The special fees collected pursuant to subsection 12
- 16 for issuance and annual validation of the special registration
- 17 plates issued under this subsection shall be paid monthly to
- 18 the treasurer of state and credited to the road use tax fund.
- 19 Notwithstanding section 423.24 and prior to the crediting of
- 20 the revenues to the road_use tax_fund under_section_423.24,
- 21 subsection 1, paragraph "b", the treasurer of state shall
- 22 credit monthly to the veterans license fee fund under section
- 23 35A.11 the amount of the special fees collected in the
- 24 previous month for the United States armed forces retired
- 25 plates.
- 26 EXPLANATION
- 27 This bill directs the treasurer of state to credit special
- 28 motor vehicle registration plate fees for Pearl Harbor license
- 29 plates and United States armed forces retired license plates
- 30 to the veterans license fee fund under the control of the
- 31 commission of veterans affairs. Moneys in that fund are
- 32 appropriated to the commission to be used to fulfill its
- 33 responsibilities. The fund consists of moneys from the
- 34 special fees for veterans registration plates.
- 35 Pearl Harbor plates are currently available to motor

1 vehicle owners who were at Pearl Harbor on December 7, 1941,
 2 as a member of the armed forces. United States armed forces
 3 retired plates representing each of the five branches of the
 4 armed services are currently available to motor vehicle owners
 5 who are retired from the armed forces. The special fee for
 6 issuance of these special plates is $25, in addition to the
 7 regular registration fee for the vehicle. The special annual
8 validation fee is $5, which is in addition to the regular
9 validation fee for the vehicle. Those special fees are
10 currently credited to the road use tax fund.
