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- 1 Section 1. Section 477C.1, Code 2003, is amended by
- 2 striking the section and inserting in lieu thereof the
- 3 following:
- 4 477C.1 TELECOMMUNICATIONS RELAY SERVICE AND EQUIPMENT
- 5 DISTRIBUTION PROGRAM -- PURPOSE.
- 6 The general assembly finds that the provision of a
- 7 statewide telecommunications relay service and equipment
- 8 distribution program will further the public interest and
- 9 protect the health, safety, and welfare of the people of Iowa
- 10 through an increase in the availability of the telephone
- 11 system and specialized telecommunications devices. Many
- 12 persons who are deaf, hard-of-hearing, speech-impaired, or
- 13 have other physical, sensory, mobility, and cognitive
- 14 impairments are not able to utilize the telephone system or
- 15 telephone equipment without this type of service or such
- 16 devices. Therefore, it is the purpose of this chapter to
- 17 facilitate the development, operation, promotion, and funding
- 18 of a statewide telecommunications relay service, and the
- 19 planning, establishment, administration, and promotion of an
- 20 equipment distribution program designed to serve the needs of
- 21 persons with communication impairments.
- 22 Sec. 2. Section 477C.2, Code 2003, is amended by striking
- 23 the section and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
- 24 477C.2 DEFINITIONS.
- 25 As used in this chapter, unless the context otherwise
- 26 requires:
- 27 1. "Board" means the utilities board within the department
- 28 of commerce created in section 474.1.
- 29 2. "Council" means the telecommunications relay council
- 30 established in section 477C.5.
- 31 3. "Person with a communication impairment" means an
- 32 individual who has been certified by an appropriate
- 33 professional to be deaf, hard-of-hearing, or have a speech,
- 34 mobility, cognitive, or other sensory or physical impairment
- 35 that limits the individual's ability to use or access a

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- 1 standard telephone for communication.
- 2 4. "Specialized telecommunications device" means any
- 3 assistive, supplemental, or adapted equipment used by a person
- 4 with a communication impairment to use or access the telephone
- 5 system.
- 6 5. "Telecommunications relay service" or "relay service"
- 7 means a communication service which provides a person with a
- 8 communication impairment access to the telephone system
- 9 functionally equivalent to the access available to persons who
- 10 do not have such impairments.
- 11 Sec. 3. Section 477C.3, Code 2003, is amended to read as
- 12 follows:
- 13 477C.3 ĐƯẠT-PARTY TELECOMMUNICATIONS RELAY SERVICE.
- 14 With the advice of the council, the board shall plan,
- 15 establish, administer, and promote a statewide program to
- 16 provide dual-party telecommunications relay service as
- 17 follows:
- 18 1. The board may enter into the necessary contracts and
- 19 arrangements with private entities to provide for the delivery
- 20 of relay service.
- 21 2. The relay service, to the extent reasonably possible,
- 22 shall allow persons with communication impairments to use the
- 23 telephone system in a manner and at a rate equivalent to
- 24 persons without-communication who do not have such
- 25 impairments.
- 26 3. The relay service may be provided on a stand-alone
- 27 basis within the state, with other states, or with telephone
- 28 utilities providing relay service in other states.
- 29 4. The board may employ additional personnel, pursuant to
- 30 section 476.10, to plan, establish, administer, and promote
- 31 the relay service.
- 32 Sec. 4. Section 477C.4, Code 2003, is amended to read as
- 33 follows:
- 34 477C.4 TELECOMMUNICATIONS-DEVICES-FOR-THE-DEAF EQUIPMENT
- 35 DISTRIBUTION PROGRAM.

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- 1 With the advice of the council, the board may plan,
- 2 establish, administer, and promote a program to secure,
- 3 finance, and distribute specialized telecommunications devices
- 4 for-the-deaf. The board may shall establish eligibility
- 5 criteria for persons with a communication impairment to
- 6 receive specialized telecommunications devices for-the-deaf,
- 7 including, but not limited to, requiring certification that
- 8 the recipient cannot use the telephone for communication
- 9 without a specialized telecommunications device for-the-deaf.
- Sec. 5. Section 477C.5, Code 2003, is amended to read as
- 11 follows:
- 12 477C.5 ĐƯAH-PARTY TELECOMMUNICATIONS RELAY COUNCIL.
- 13 1. A dual-party telecommunications relay council is
- 14 established, consisting of eleven members appointed by the
- 15 board. The council shall advise the board on all matters
- 16 concerning relay service and equipment distribution programs.
- 17 2. The council shall consist of:
- a. Six consumers who have are persons with a communication
- 19 impairments impairment.
- 20 b. Two representatives from telephone companies.
- 21 c. One representative from the division of deaf services
- 22 of the department of human rights.
- d. One representative from the office of the consumer
- 24 advocate of the department of justice.
- 25 e. One member of the board or a designee of the board.
- 26 3. Council members who are not state or local government
- 27 officers or employees shall be reimbursed for their necessary
- 28 and actual expenses incurred in performance of their duties
- 29 and shall receive a per diem of fifty dollars when the council
- 30 is meeting, payable from moneys available to the board
- 31 pursuant to section 477C.7.
- 32 Sec. 6. CODE EDITOR DIRECTIVE. The Code editor shall
- 33 correct any references to the telecommunications relay service
- 34 as the successor to the dual party relay service, including
- 35 grammatical constructions, anywhere else in the Iowa Code, in

1 any bills awaiting codification, and in any bills enacted by 2 the Eightieth General Assembly, 2004 Regular Session. 3 EXPLANATION 4 This bill provides for the establishment of a 5 telecommunications relay service and equipment distribution 6 program. The bill involves terminology changes and an 7 expanded scope from the dual party relay provisions currently 8 contained within Code chapter 477C. The bill provides a statement of purpose section setting 10 forth the rationale for the program. The bill provides that a 11 statewide telecommunications relay service and equipment 12 distribution program will further the public interest and 13 protect the health, safety, and welfare of the people of Iowa 14 through an increase in the availability of the telephone 15 system and specialized telecommunications devices. 16 provides that many persons who are deaf, hard-of-hearing, 17 speech-impaired, or otherwise impaired are not able to utilize 18 the telephone system or telephone equipment without such a 19 service or such devices, and that accordingly, the purpose of 20 the chapter is to facilitate the development, operation, 21 promotion, and funding of a statewide telecommunications relay 22 service, and the planning, establishment, administration, and 23 promotion of an equipment distribution program designed to 24 serve the needs of persons with communication impairments. The bill provides that references to "dual party" relay 25 26 service shall be changed to "telecommunications" relay 27 service, and changes the definition of "communication 28 impairment" to a "person with a communication impairment". 29 The bill provides that a person with a communication 30 impairment means an individual who has been certified by an 31 appropriate professional to be deaf, hard-of-hearing, or have 32 a speech, mobility, cognitive, or other sensory or physical 33 impairment that limits the individual's ability to use or 34 access a standard telephone for communication. The bill 35 provides that a "telecommunications relay service" or "relay

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1 service" means a communication service which provides a person
2 with a communication impairment access to the telephone system
3 functionally equivalent to the access available to persons who
4 do not have such impairments, and that a "specialized
5 telecommunications device" means any assistive, supplemental,
6 or adapted equipment used by a person with a communication
7 impairment to use or access the telephone system. The bill
8 provides for changes in several sections of Code chapter 477C
9 consistent with these revised definitions.
      The bill additionally provides that, in regard to the
10
11 equipment distribution program, the board shall establish
12 eligibility criteria for persons to receive specialized
13 telecommunications devices. Currently, Code section 477C.4
14 provides that the board "may" establish such criteria.
15 bill also provides, in regard to the telecommunications relay
16 council, that the six consumer members shall be persons with a
17 communication impairment. Currently, the requirement is
18 phrased "impairments".
      The Code editor is directed to make all necessary changes
19
20 to existing provisions of the Code and prospective enactments
21 by the general assembly.
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
