EXPLANATION
This bill relates to the standards for child development 14 home provider qualifications adopted as rules by the 15 department of human services.
16 Under current law, the department standards for the child
17 development homes are required to utilize three categories
18 ("A", "B", and "C") ranked from least stringent to most
19 stringent. The bill applies to the standards for provider 20 qualifications in category "C" when more than one provider is

Section l. Section 237A.3A, subsection 3, Code Supplement 2003, is amended by adding the following new paragraph:

NEW PARAGRAPH. d. The standards for provider times when more than one qualified provider must be present shall require one of the providers to meet the provider imediate importance, takes effect upon enactment. required to be present. The bill provides that one of the providers present must meet the provider qualifications for category "C", but other providers required to be present shall be allowed to meet the provider qualifications for either category "B" or "C".
