- 1 Section 1. Section 613.17, Code 2003, is amended to read 2 as follows:
- 3 613.17 EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE IN AN ACCIDENT.
- 4 1. A person, who in good faith renders emergency care or
- 5 assistance without compensation, shall not be liable for any
- 6 civil damages for acts or omissions occurring at the place of
- 7 an emergency or accident or while the person is in transit to
- 8 or from the emergency or accident or while the person is at or
- 9 being moved to or from an emergency shelter unless such acts
- 10 or omissions constitute recklessness.
- 11 2. For purposes of this section, if the following shall
- 12 apply:
- 13 a. If a volunteer fire fighter, a volunteer operator or
- 14 attendant of an ambulance or rescue squad service, a volunteer
- 15 paramedic, a volunteer emergency medical technician, a
- 16 volunteer critical incident stress team member, or a volunteer
- 17 registered member of the national ski patrol system receives
- 18 nominal compensation not based upon the value of the services
- 19 performed, that person shall be considered to be receiving no
- 20 compensation.
- 21 b. The operation of a motor vehicle in compliance with
- 22 section 321.231 by a volunteer fire fighter, volunteer
- 23 operator, or attendant of an ambulance or rescue squad
- 24 service, a volunteer paramedic, or volunteer emergency medical
- 25 technician shall be considered rendering emergency care or
- 26 assistance for purposes of this section. For-purposes-of-this
- 27 section -- a
- 28 c. A person rendering emergency care or assistance
- 29 includes a person involved in a workplace rescue arising out
- 30 of an emergency or accident.
- 31 3. For purposes of this section, "volunteer critical
- 32 incident stress team member" means a person who is a member of
- 33 a volunteer critical incident stress team who is trained to
- 34 provide crisis counseling to emergency service personnel at
- 35 the scene of and after an emergency or accident. For purposes

1 of this subsection, "emergency service personnel" includes, 2 but is not limited to, emergency medical technicians, police 3 officers, fire fighters, dispatchers, paramedics, and mental 4 health personnel. The Iowa department of public health shall 5 adopt rules pursuant to chapter 17A to further define 6 "volunteer critical incident stress team management members". **EXPLANATION** This bill relates to the provision of emergency crisis 8 9 counseling at the place of an emergency or accident by a 10 volunteer critical incident stress team member. The bill provides that a volunteer critical incident stress 11 12 team member who receives nominal compensation not based upon 13 the value of the services performed at the place of an 14 emergency or an accident shall be considered to be receiving 15 no compensation and shall not be liable for any civil damages 16 for acts or omissions occurring at the place of the emergency 17 or accident while in transit to or from the emergency or 18 accident or while at or being moved to or from an emergency 19 shelter, unless such acts or omissions constitute negligence. The bill defines a "volunteer critical incident stress team 20 21 member" to mean a person who is a member of a volunteer 22 critical incident stress team who provides emergency crisis 23 counseling to emergency service personnel at the scene of and 24 after an emergency or accident. "Emergency service personnel" 25 includes, but is not limited to, emergency medical 26 technicians, police officers, fire fighters, dispatchers, 27 paramedics, and mental health personnel. The Iowa department 28 of public health shall adopt rules further defining volunteer 29 critical incident stress team management members. 30 31 32 33 34 35
