1 to the regulation of animal feeding operations by the 2 department of natural resources, including confinement feeding 3 operations.

4 Various provisions of the chapter require separation 5 distance requirements to be established between confinement 6 feeding operation structures (buildings, manure storage areas, 7 and egg washwater storage areas) and homes, schools, 8 businesses, and churches. Different separation distance 9 requirements apply between confinement feeding operation 10 structures and public use areas (portions of parks and 11 cemeteries) or homes, schools, businesses, and churches.

12 The bill prohibits a person from establishing or expanding 13 a home, school, business, church, or public use area within 14 the same separation distances that apply to prohibiting the 15 construction or expansion of a confinement feeding operation 16 structure within proximity of one of these places. There is 17 one exception: the current Code chapter's requirements do not 18 apply to the construction of small animal feeding operations 19 (having an animal unit capacity of 500 or fewer animal units). 20 The bill provides that the new separation distance 21 requirements preclude the establishment or expansion of one of 22 the places in proximity to a confinement feeding operation 23 structure, regardless of the confinement feeding operation's 24 size.

Generally, a person who violates a provision of Code Chapter 459, subchapter II, is subject to a civil penalty not to exceed \$10,000 (see Code sections 459.602 and 455B.109).
