This Act, being deemed of 8 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment. 9 EXPLANATION 10 During the 2003 legislative session the General Assembly 11 passed House File 624 (2003 Acts, chapter 149) regulating farm 12 deer, including whitetail deer. The bill effectively 13 transferred regulatory authority from the department of 14 natural resources under Code chapter 484 (which supervises 15 hunting preserves) to the department of agriculture and land 16 stewardship under new Code chapter 170. That Code chapter 17 does not currently provide for the assessment of fees. This 18 bill provides that the department may impose, assess, and 19 collect fees as required to administer the chapter.
