	BE	IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 481A.123, Code 2003, is amended by
- 2 adding the following new subsections:
- 3 NEW SUBSECTION. 3. This section does not apply to the
- 4 discharge of a firearm for the purpose of target shooting on
- 5 premises posted as a target shooting range, if the premises
- 6 have been used as a target shooting range prior to the
- 7 erection of a building inhabited by people or domestic
- 8 livestock, or prior to the construction of a feedlot, located
- 9 within two hundred yards of the target shooting range. This
- 10 subsection applies only to the erection of a building
- 11 inhabited by people or domestic livestock or to the

1 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment. 2 **EXPLANATION** 3 This bill provides that target shooting on premises posted 4 as a target shooting range is exempt from the requirement that 5 a firearm cannot be discharged within 200 yards of a building 6 inhabited by people or domestic livestock, or of a feedlot, 7 unless the owner or tenant has given consent, if the premises 8 have been used as a target shooting range prior to the 9 erection of such a building or construction of a feedlot. The 10 bill applies only to the erection of such a building or 11 construction of a feedlot within 200 yards of a target 12 shooting range that is identified as such by the city, county, 13 state, or federal government where the erection or 14 construction occurs on or after the effective date of the 15 bill. For the purposes of the bill, "target shooting" means 16 the discharge of a firearm at an inanimate object, for 17 amusement or as a test of skill in marksmanship. A violation 18 of Code section 481A.123 is punishable by a scheduled fine of 19 \$25 under Code section 805.8B. 20 The bill also provides that the discharge of a firearm on 21 premises posted as a public hunting area is exempt from the 22 requirement that a firearm cannot be discharged within 200 23 yards of a building inhabited by people or domestic livestock, 24 or of a feedlot, if the premises have been identified as a 25 public hunting area prior to the erection of such a building 26 or construction of a feedlot. The provision applies only to 27 the erection of such a building or construction of a feedlot 28 within 200 yards of a public hunting range that is identified 29 as such by the city, county, state, or federal government and 30 where the erection or construction occurs on or after the 31 effective date of the bill. 32 The bill is effective upon enactment. 33 34 35

RELATING TO THE REGULATION OF TARGET SHOOTING NEAR BUILDINGS
AND FEEDLOTS AND THE REGULATION OF PUBLIC HUNTING NEAR
BUILDINGS AND FEEDLOTS AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 481A.123, Code 2003, is amended by adding the following new subsections:

NEW SUBSECTION. 3. This section does not apply to the discharge of a firearm for the purpose of target shooting on premises posted as a target shooting range that is open to the public, if the premises have been used as a target shooting range prior to the erection of a building inhabited by people or domestic livestock, or prior to the construction of a feedlot, located within two hundred yards of the target shooting range. This subsection applies only to the erection of a building inhabited by people or domestic livestock or to the construction of a feedlot located within two hundred yards of a target shooting range that is open to the public and that is identified as a target shooting range by the city, county, state, or federal government, which erection or construction occurs on or after the effective date of this Act.

As used in this subsection, "target shooting" means the discharge of a firearm at an inanimate object, for amusement or as a test of skill in marksmanship.

NEW SUBSECTION. 4. This section does not apply to the discharge of a firearm on premises identified as a public hunting area, if the premises have been identified as a public hunting area prior to the erection of a building inhabited by people or domestic livestock, or prior to the construction of

a feedlot, located within two hundred yards of the public hunting area. This subsection applies only to the erection of a building inhabited by people or domestic livestock or to the construction of a feedlot located within two hundred yards of a public hunting area, which erection or construction occurs on or after the effective date of this Act.

As used in this subsection, "public hunting area" means public lands or waters available for hunting by the public, and identified as a public hunting area by the city, county, state, or federal government.

Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment.
