1 Section 1. Section 483A.24, subsection 13, Code 2003, is 2 amended to read as follows:

- 3 13. Upon-payment-of-the-fee-of-thirty-dollars-for-a
- 4 lifetime-hunting-and-fishing-combined-license,-the-department
- 5 The commission shall issue without charge a special lifetime
- 6 hunting and fishing combined license to a resident of Iowa who

## 16 EXPLANATION

- 17 This bill provides that the natural resource commission
- 18 shall issue a free special lifetime hunting and fishing
- 19 combined license to a resident of Iowa who is a veteran, as
- 20 defined in Code section 35.1. Code section 35.1 defines a
- 21 veteran as a resident of this state who served in the armed
- 22 forces of the United States at any time during certain
- 23 specified dates and who was discharged under honorable
- 24 conditions. Code section 35.1 also provides that a veteran
- 25 includes certain persons who served in the reserve forces of
- 26 the United States and the Iowa national guard as well as other
- 27 specified entities.
- 28 Currently, such a special lifetime hunting and fishing
- 29 combined license is available only to a veteran who was
- 30 disabled or was a prisoner of war during the veteran's
- 31 military service, for a fee of \$30.
