1 Section 1. Section 99B.10, subsection 4, Code Supplement 2 2003, is amended to read as follows:

3 4. Each electrical and mechanical amusement device in 4 operation or distributed in this state that awards a prize, as 5 provided in this section, where the outcome is not primarily 6 determined by the skill or knowledge of the operator, is 7 registered by the department as provided by this subsection. 8 For-an-organization-that-meets-the-requirements-of-section 9 99B-77-subsection-17-paragraph-"m"7-no-more-than-four7-and-for 10 all-other-persons,-no No more than two four electrical and 11 mechanical amusement devices registered as provided by this 12 subsection shall be permitted or offered for use in any single 13 location or premises. Each person owning an electrical and 14 mechanical amusement device in this state shall obtain a 15 registration tag for each electrical and mechanical amusement 16 device owned that is required to be registered as provided in 17 this subsection. Upon receipt of an application and a fee of 18 twenty-five dollars for each device required to be registered, 19 the department shall issue an annual registration tag which 20 tag shall be displayed as required by rules adopted by the 21 department. The application shall be submitted on forms 22 designated by the department and contain the information 23 required by rule of the department. A registration may be 24 renewed annually upon submission of a registration application 25 and payment of the annual registration fee and compliance with 26 this chapter and the rules adopted pursuant to this chapter. 27 A person owning or leasing an electrical and mechanical 28 amusement device required to be registered under this 29 subsection shall only own or lease an electrical and 30 mechanical amusement device that is required to be registered 31 that has been purchased from a manufacturer, manufacturer's 32 representative, or distributor registered with the department 33 under section 99B.10A.

## EXPLANATION

This bill allows up to four registered electrical and

1 mechanical amusement devices to be permitted or offered for 2 use in any single location or premises. Under current law, 3 only nonprofit organizations are allowed up to four registered 4 amusement devices in any single location while all other 5 persons are allowed only two.
