A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to recycling waste oil filters and establishing
2 fees.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 455D.13, Code 2003, is amended to read
2 as follows:

3 455D.13 LAND DISPOSAL OF WASTE OIL PROHIBITED --
4 COLLECTION.

5 1. A sanitary landfill shall not accept waste oil for
6 final disposal ~~beginning July 1, 1990.~~ Beginning July 1,
7 2004, a sanitary landfill shall not accept waste oil filters
8 or oil-contaminated material for final disposal but may
9 receive such materials for recycling purposes.

10 2. A person offering for sale or selling oil or oil
11 filters at retail in the state shall do the following:

12 a. Accept at the point of sale, waste oil, waste oil
13 filters, and oil-contaminated material from customers, or post
14 notice of locations where a customer may dispose of waste oil,
15 waste oil filters, and oil-contaminated material.

16 b. Post written notice that it is unlawful to dispose of
17 waste oil, waste oil filters, or oil-contaminated material in
18 a sanitary landfill.

19 3. A sanitary landfill or person offering for sale or
20 selling oil or oil filters at retail or any other person that
21 accepts waste oil filters or oil-contaminated material shall
22 notify the department. The department shall make a list of
23 such entities available to retailers for purposes of the
24 notification requirements in subsection 2, paragraph "a".

25 EXPLANATION

26 This bill relates to the recycling of waste oil filters and
27 oil-contaminated material.

28 The bill prohibits the land disposal of waste oil filters
29 and oil-contaminated material beginning July 1, 2004, but
30 allows a sanitary landfill to receive such materials for
31 recycling purposes. The bill also provides that the notice
32 and collection requirements for waste oil filters and oil-
33 contaminated material are the same as for waste oil.

34 The bill provides that a sanitary landfill or person
35 offering for sale or selling oil or oil filters at retail of

1 any other person that accepts waste oil filters or oil-
2 contaminated material shall notify the department. The bill
3 provides that the department shall make a list of such
4 entities available to retailers for purposes of the
5 notification requirements.
