1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 455B.307B SOLID WASTE
2 COMMISSIONER.

3 1. For purposes of this section, "commissioner" means the4 solid waste commissioner in a county.

5 2. The board of supervisors of each county may annually 6 appoint a solid waste commissioner for the county. The board 7 of supervisors may appoint the commissioner from 8 recommendations by the county board of health or may select a 9 person outside the recommendations made by the county board of

10 health. The board of supervisors shall appoint a person who 11 is a citizen of the United States, is of good moral character, 12 and has not previously been convicted of a felony.

13 3. A county solid waste commissioner shall take an oath of 14 office prescribed by the board of supervisors. A 15 commissioner's appointment shall be effective March 1 and 16 shall continue for a term at the discretion of the board of 17 supervisors.

4. A county solid waste commissioner, subject to direction and control by the county board of supervisors, shall only be empowered to enforce the provisions of sections 455B.307A and 1455B.363 and local littering ordinances. A commissioner shall not have the duty to enforce any other traffic or criminal laws of the state, county, or a municipality. A commissioner any enter upon any public land in the county, excluding land within the limits of cities, unless otherwise authorized by a city, at any time for the performance of the commissioner's duties, and may hire the labor and equipment necessary subject to the approval of the board of supervisors.

5. A person shall not willfully obstruct, resist, impede, or interfere with a county solid waste commissioner in connection with the commissioner's enforcement of sections 455B.307A and 455B.363 and local littering ordinances. A person shall not willfully retaliate or discriminate in any a manner against a commissioner as a reprisal for any act or omission of the commissioner. A person violating this

This bill relates to solid waste commissioners.

4 The bill provides that the board of supervisors of each 5 county may annually appoint a solid waste commissioner. The 6 bill provides that the board of supervisors may appoint the 7 commissioner from recommendations by the county board of 8 health or may select a person outside the recommendations made 9 by the county board of health. The bill provides that the 10 board of supervisors shall appoint a person who is a citizen 11 of the United States, is of good moral character, and has not 12 previously been convicted of a felony.

13 The bill provides that a county solid waste commissioner 14 shall take an oath of office prescribed by the board of 15 supervisors. The bill provides that a commissioner's 16 appointment shall be effective March 1 and shall continue for 17 a term at the discretion of the board of supervisors.

The bill provides that a county solid waste commissioner shall, subject to direction and control by the county board of supervisors, only be empowered to enforce the provisions of Code sections 455B.307A, relating to the discarding of solid waste, and 455B.363, relating to litter, and local littering ordinances. The bill provides that a commissioner shall not have the duty to enforce any other traffic or criminal laws of the state, county, or a municipality. The bill allows a commissioner to enter upon any public land in the county, excluding land within the limits of cities, unless otherwise authorized by a city, at any time for the performance of the labor and equipment necessary subject to the approval of the loard of supervisors.
