A BILL FOR

1 An Act making appropriations to the community attraction and  
2 tourism fund.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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HF 253

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the tax-exempt bond  
2 proceeds restricted capital funds account of the tobacco  
3 settlement trust fund to the office of the treasurer of state  
4 for the fiscal period beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June  
5 30, 2006, the following amounts to be deposited in the  
6 community attraction and tourism fund created in section  
7 15F.204:

8	FY 2004-2005 .....	\$ 12,500,000
9	FY 2005-2006 .....	\$ 12,500,000

10 Payment of moneys from the appropriations in this section  
11 shall be made in a manner that does not adversely affect the  
12 tax-exempt status of any outstanding bonds issued by the  
13 tobacco settlement authority.

14 EXPLANATION

15 This bill relates to the community attraction and tourism  
16 fund administered by the vision Iowa board.

17 The bill appropriates moneys from the tax-exempt bond  
18 proceeds restricted capital funds account of the tobacco  
19 settlement trust fund to the office of the treasurer of state  
20 for deposit in the community attraction and tourism fund. The  
21 bill appropriates \$12.5 million for both FY 2004-2005 and FY  
22 2005-2006. The bill requires that payment of moneys from the  
23 appropriations shall be made in a manner that does not  
24 adversely affect the tax-exempt status of any outstanding  
25 bonds issued by the tobacco settlement authority.

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
