A BILL FOR

1 An Act providing for the disposition and sale of certain state-
2 owned motor vehicles and making an appropriation.
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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HF 2547

1 Section 1. DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES -- STATE-
2 OWNED PASSENGER VEHICLES -- DISPOSITION AND SALE --
3 DISTRIBUTION OF PROCEEDS.

4 1. Consistent with the requirements of section 8A.361, the
5 department of administrative services shall be the sole
6 department authorized to operate a pool of passenger vehicles
7 located in Polk county for temporary assignment to multiple
8 drivers of a state department or agency that is located within
9 Polk county. By September 30, 2004, all passenger vehicles
10 located in Polk county and designated for use by multiple
11 drivers that are assigned to a state department or agency
12 within Polk county on January 1, 2004, or later shall be
13 returned to the department of administrative services for use
14 and disposition as provided by this section.

15 2. On or before December 31, 2004, the department of
16 administrative services shall sell at auction thirty percent
17 of passenger vehicles returned to the department of
18 administrative services pursuant to subsection 1 and passenger
19 vehicles otherwise under the control of the department for use
20 by multiple drivers of state departments or agencies within
21 Polk county. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 8A.364
22 to the contrary, proceeds from the sale of motor vehicles as
23 provided by this subsection shall be deposited in the
24 depreciation account of the department of public safety and
25 are appropriated for the purchase of motor vehicles for the
26 Iowa state patrol.

27 3. For purposes of this section, "passenger vehicles"
28 means United States environmental protection agency designated
29 compact sedans, compact wagons, midsize sedans, midsize
30 wagons, full-size sedans, and passenger minivans. "Passenger
31 vehicles" does not mean utility vehicles, vans other than
32 passenger minivans, fire trucks, ambulances, motor homes,
33 buses, medium-duty and heavy-duty trucks, heavy construction
34 equipment, and other highway maintenance vehicles, vehicles
35 assigned for law enforcement purposes, and any other classes

1 of vehicles of limited application approved by the director of
2 the department of administrative services.

3 EXPLANATION

4 This bill concerns the disposition and sale of certain
5 state-owned passenger vehicles.

6 The bill provides that the department of administrative
7 services shall be the sole department authorized to operate a
8 pool of passenger vehicles located in Polk county for
9 temporary assignments to multiple drivers of a state
10 department or agency that is located within Polk county. The
11 bill provides that by September 30, 2004, all such passenger
12 vehicles that are assigned to a state department or agency
13 within Polk county on January 1, 2004, or later shall be
14 returned to the department of administrative services. The
15 bill then provides that on or before December 31, 2004, the
16 department shall sell at auction 30 percent of the vehicles
17 returned to the department and other passenger vehicles
18 otherwise under the control of the department and used in a
19 pool of vehicles for use by multiple drivers in Polk county.
20 The bill then provides that the proceeds from the sale of
21 these passenger vehicles be deposited in the depreciation
22 account of the department of public safety and are
23 appropriated for the purchase of vehicles for the Iowa state
24 patrol.

1 Amend House File 2547 as follows:

2 1. Page 2, by inserting after line 2 the
3 following:

4 "Sec. ____ . MOTOR VEHICLE FRANCHISEES -- STUDY.

5 The department of administrative services shall
6 provide for a comprehensive review of the laws and
7 administrative rules regulating motor vehicle
8 franchises pursuant to chapters 322 and 322A. The
9 department shall report the findings of the review to
10 the house and senate committees on government
11 oversight no later than December 31, 2004. The report
12 shall include identification of any provisions which
13 may adversely affect franchisers and franchisees along
14 with proposed remedies. Costs incurred by the
15 department for conducting the review shall be paid
16 from moneys appropriated to the department for general
17 operating costs. At the direction of the department,
18 the review and report may be completed by a private,
19 nonprofit corporation with proven experience in
20 mediation."

21 2. Title page, line 1, by inserting after the
22 word "Act" the following: "relating to motor
23 vehicles, requiring a review of motor vehicle
24 franchise laws,".

25 3. By renumbering as necessary.
