A BILL FOR							
1	An Act relating to discrimination based upon a person's sexual						
2	orientation under the Iowa civil rights Act.						
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 216.2, Code 2003, is amended by adding
- 2 the following new subsection:
- NEW SUBSECTION. 12A. "Sexual orientation" means actual or
- 4 perceived heterosexuality, homosexuality, bisexuality, or a
- 5 person's attributes in behavior, practice, or appearance as
- 6 they are understood to be masculine or feminine. "Sexual
- 7 orientation" does not include participation in acts which are
- 8 prohibited by law.
- 9 Sec. 2. Section 216.5, subsections 6 and 8, Code 2003, are
- 10 amended to read as follows:
- 11 6. To issue such publications and reports of
- 12 investigations and research as in the judgment of the
- 13 commission shall tend to promote good will among the various
- 14 racial, religious, and ethnic groups of the state and which
- 15 shall tend to minimize or eliminate discrimination in public
- 16 accommodations, employment, apprenticeship and on-the-job
- 17 training programs, vocational schools, or housing because of
- 18 race, creed, color, sex, sexual orientation, national origin,
- 19 religion, ancestry, or disability.
- 20 8. To make recommendations to the general assembly for
- 21 such further legislation concerning discrimination because of
- 22 race, creed, color, sex, sexual orientation, national origin,
- 23 religion, ancestry, or disability as it may deem necessary and
- 24 desirable.
- 25 Sec. 3. Section 216.6, subsection 1, paragraphs a, b, and
- 26 c, Code 2003, are amended to read as follows:
- 27 a. Person to refuse to hire, accept, register, classify,
- 28 or refer for employment, to discharge any employee, or to
- 29 otherwise discriminate in employment against any applicant for
- 30 employment or any employee because of the age, race, creed,
- 31 color, sex, sexual orientation, national origin, religion, or
- 32 disability of such applicant or employee, unless based upon
- 33 the nature of the occupation. If a person with a disability
- 34 is qualified to perform a particular occupation, by reason of
- 35 training or experience, the nature of that occupation shall

- 1 not be the basis for exception to the unfair or discriminating
 2 practices prohibited by this subsection.
- 3 b. Labor organization or the employees, agents, or members
- 4 thereof to refuse to admit to membership any applicant, to
- 5 expel any member, or to otherwise discriminate against any
- 6 applicant for membership or any member in the privileges,
- 7 rights, or benefits of such membership because of the age,
- 8 race, creed, color, sex, sexual orientation, national origin,
- 9 religion, or disability of such applicant or member.
- 10 c. Employer, employment agency, labor organization, or the
- 11 employees, agents, or members thereof to directly or
- 12 indirectly advertise or in any other manner indicate or
- 13 publicize that individuals of any particular age, race, creed,
- 14 color, sex, sexual orientation, national origin, religion, or
- 15 disability are unwelcome, objectionable, not acceptable, or
- 16 not solicited for employment or membership unless based on the
- 17 nature of the occupation. If a person with a disability is
- 18 qualified to perform a particular occupation by reason of
- 19 training or experience, the nature of that occupation shall
- 20 not be the basis for exception to the unfair or discriminating
- 21 practices prohibited by this subsection.
- 22 An employer, employment agency, or their employees,
- 23 servants, or agents may offer employment or advertise for
- 24 employment to only persons with disabilities, when other
- 25 applicants have available to them other employment compatible
- 26 with their ability which would not be available to persons
- 27 with disabilities because of their disabilities. Any such
- 28 employment or offer of employment shall not discriminate among
- 29 persons with disabilities on the basis of race, color, creed,
- 30 sex, sexual orientation, or national origin.
- 31 Sec. 4. Section 216.6, subsection 6, paragraph d, Code
- 32 2003, is amended to read as follows:
- 33 d. Any bona fide religious institution or its educational
- 34 facility, association, corporation, or society with respect to
- 35 any qualifications for employment based on religion or sexual

- 1 orientation when such qualifications are related to a bona
- 2 fide religious purpose. A religious qualification for
- 3 instructional personnel or an administrative officer, serving
- 4 in a supervisory capacity of a bona fide religious educational
- 5 facility or religious institution, shall be presumed to be a
- 6 bona fide occupational qualification.
- 7 Sec. 5. Section 216.7, subsection 1, paragraphs a and b,
- 8 Code 2003, are amended to read as follows:
- 9 a. To refuse or deny to any person because of race, creed,
- 10 color, sex, sexual orientation, national origin, religion, or
- 11 disability the accommodations, advantages, facilities,
- 12 services, or privileges thereof, or otherwise to discriminate
- 13 against any person because of race, creed, color, sex, sexual
- 14 orientation, national origin, religion, or disability in the
- 15 furnishing of such accommodations, advantages, facilities,
- 16 services, or privileges.
- 17 b. To directly or indirectly advertise or in any other
- 18 manner indicate or publicize that the patronage of persons of
- 19 any particular race, creed, color, sex, sexual orientation,
- 20 national origin, religion, or disability is unwelcome,
- 21 objectionable, not acceptable, or not solicited.
- Sec. 6. Section 216.7, subsection 2, paragraph a, Code
- 23 2003, is amended to read as follows:
- 24 a. Any bona fide religious institution with respect to any
- 25 qualifications the institution may impose based on religion or
- 26 sexual orientation when such qualifications are related to a
- 27 bona fide religious purpose.
- Sec. 7. Section 216.8, subsections 1 through 4, Code 2003,
- 29 are amended to read as follows:
- To refuse to sell, rent, lease, assign, sublease,
- 31 refuse to negotiate, or to otherwise make unavailable, or deny
- 32 any real property or housing accommodation or part, portion or
- 33 interest therein, to any person because of the race, color,
- 34 creed, sex, sexual orientation, religion, national origin,
- 35 disability, or familial status of such person.

- 2. To discriminate against any person because of the
- 2 person's race, color, creed, sex, sexual orientation,
- 3 religion, national origin, disability, or familial status, in
- 4 the terms, conditions or privileges of the sale, rental, lease
- 5 assignment or sublease of any real property or housing
- 6 accommodation or any part, portion or interest in the real
- 7 property or housing accommodation or in the provision of
- 8 services or facilities in connection with the real property or
- 9 housing accommodation.
- 10 For purposes of this section, "person" means one or more
- 11 individuals, corporations, partnerships, associations, labor
- 12 organizations, legal representatives, mutual companies, joint
- 13 stock companies, trusts, unincorporated organizations,
- 14 trustees, trustees in cases under Title 11 of the United
- 15 States Code, receivers, and fiduciaries.
- 16 3. To directly or indirectly advertise, or in any other
- 17 manner indicate or publicize that the purchase, rental, lease,
- 18 assignment, or sublease of any real property or housing
- 19 accommodation or any part, portion or interest therein, by
- 20 persons of any particular race, color, creed, sex, sexual
- 21 orientation, religion, national origin, disability, or
- 22 familial status is unwelcome, objectionable, not acceptable or
- 23 not solicited.
- 24 4. To discriminate against the lessee or purchaser of any
- 25 real property or housing accommodation or part, portion or
- 26 interest of the real property or housing accommodation, or
- 27 against any prospective lessee or purchaser of the property or
- 28 accommodation, because of the race, color, creed, religion,
- 29 sex, sexual orientation, disability, age, or national origin
- 30 of persons who may from time to time be present in or on the
- 31 lessee's or owner's premises for lawful purposes at the
- 32 invitation of the lessee or owner as friends, guests,
- 33 visitors, relatives or in any similar capacity.
- 34 Sec. 8. Section 216.8A, subsections 1 and 2, Code 2003,
- 35 are amended to read as follows:

- 1 1. A person shall not induce or attempt to induce another
- 2 person to sell or rent a dwelling by representations regarding
- 3 the entry or prospective entry into a neighborhood of a person
- 4 of a particular race, color, creed, sex, sexual orientation,
- 5 religion, national origin, disability, or familial status.
- 6 2. A person shall not represent to a person of a
- 7 particular race, color, creed, sex, sexual orientation,
- 8 religion, national origin, disability, or familial status that
- 9 a dwelling is not available for inspection, sale, or rental
- 10 when the dwelling is available for inspection, sale, or
- 11 rental.
- 12 Sec. 9. Section 216.8A, subsection 4, paragraph a, Code
- 13 2003, is amended to read as follows:
- 14 a. A person whose business includes engaging in resi-
- 15 dential real estate related transactions shall not
- 16 discriminate against a person in making a residential real
- 17 estate related transaction available or in terms or conditions
- 18 of a residential real estate related transaction because of
- 19 race, color, creed, sex, sexual orientation, religion,
- 20 national origin, disability, or familial status.
- 21 Sec. 10. Section 216.8A, subsection 5, Code 2003, is
- 22 amended to read as follows:
- 23 5. A person shall not deny another person access to, or
- 24 membership or participation in, a multiple-listing service,
- 25 real estate brokers' organization or other service,
- 26 organization, or facility relating to the business of selling
- 27 or renting dwellings, or discriminate against a person in
- 28 terms or conditions of access, membership, or participation in
- 29 such organization because of race, color, creed, sex, sexual
- 30 orientation, religion, national origin, disability, or
- 31 familial status.
- 32 Sec. 11. Section 216.9, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 2003,
- 33 is amended to read as follows:
- 34 It is an unfair or discriminatory practice for any
- 35 educational institution to discriminate on the basis of race,

- 1 creed, color, sex, sexual orientation, national origin,
- 2 religion, or disability in any program or activity. Such
- 3 discriminatory practices shall include but not be limited to
- 4 the following practices:
- 5 Sec. 12. Section 216.9, unnumbered paragraph 2, Code 2003,
- 6 is amended to read as follows:
- 7 For the purpose of this section "educational institution"
- 8 includes any preschool, elementary, secondary, or community
- 9 college, area education agency, or postsecondary college or
- 10 university and their governing boards. This section does not
- 11 prohibit an educational institution from maintaining separate
- 12 toilet facilities, locker rooms or living facilities for the
- 13 different sexes so long as comparable facilities are provided.
- 14 Nothing in this section shall be construed as prohibiting any
- 15 bona fide religious institution from imposing qualifications
- 16 based on religion or sexual orientation when such
- 17 qualifications are related to a bona fide religious purpose or
- 18 any institution from admitting students of only one sex.
- 19 Sec. 13. Section 216.10, Code 2003, is amended to read as
- 20 follows:
- 21 216.10 UNFAIR CREDIT PRACTICES.
- 22 It shall be an unfair or discriminatory practice for any:
- 23 l. Creditor to refuse to enter into a consumer credit
- 24 transaction or impose finance charges or other terms or
- 25 conditions more onerous than those regularly extended by that
- 26 creditor to consumers of similar economic backgrounds because
- 27 of age, color, creed, national origin, race, religion, marital
- 28 status, sex, sexual orientation, physical disability, or
- 29 familial status.
- 30 2. Person authorized or licensed to do business in this
- 31 state pursuant to chapter 524, 533, 534, 536, or 536A to
- 32 refuse to loan or extend credit or to impose terms or
- 33 conditions more onerous than those regularly extended to
- 34 persons of similar economic backgrounds because of age, color,
- 35 creed, national origin, race, religion, marital status, sex,

- 1 sexual orientation, physical disability, or familial status.
- Creditor to refuse to offer credit life or health and
- 3 accident insurance because of color, creed, national origin,
- 4 race, religion, marital status, age, physical disability, sex,
- 5 sexual orientation, or familial status. Refusal by a creditor
- 6 to offer credit life or health and accident insurance based
- 7 upon the age or physical disability of the consumer shall not
- 8 be an unfair or discriminatory practice if such denial is
- 9 based solely upon bona fide underwriting considerations not
- 10 prohibited by title XIII, subtitle 1.
- 11 The provisions of this section shall not be construed by
- 12 negative implication or otherwise to narrow or restrict any
- 13 other provisions of this chapter.
- 14 Sec. 14. Section 216.12, subsection 1, Code 2003, is
- 15 amended to read as follows:
- 16 l. Any bona fide religious institution with respect to any
- 17 qualifications it may impose based on religion or sexual
- 18 orientation, when the qualifications are related to a bona
- 19 fide religious purpose unless the religious institution owns
- 20 or operates property for a commercial purpose or membership in
- 21 the religion is restricted on account of race, color, or
- 22 national origin.
- 23 Sec. 15. Section 216.12A, Code 2003, is amended to read as
- 24 follows:
- 25 216.12A ADDITIONAL HOUSING EXCEPTION.
- 26 Sections 216.8 and 216.8A do not prohibit a person engaged
- 27 in the business of furnishing appraisals of real estate from
- 28 taking into consideration factors other than race, color,
- 29 creed, sex, sexual orientation, religion, national origin,
- 30 disability, or familial status in appraising real estate.
- 31 EXPLANATION
- 32 This bill defines "sexual orientation" and prohibits
- 33 discriminatory employment, public accommodation, housing,
- 34 education, and credit practices based upon a person's sexual
- 35 orientation. However, the bill does allow for the imposition

1 of qualifications by bona fide religious institutions based
2 upon sexual orientation if related to a bona fide religious
3 purpose.
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
