- 1 Section 1. Section 422.7, Code 2003, is amended by adding 2 the following new subsection:
- 3 NEW SUBSECTION. 39. a. For an individual who volunteers
- 4 either as an emergency medical services provider or as a fire
- 5 fighter, or as both, for at least six months of the tax year,
- 6 subtract two thousand five hundred dollars.
- 7 b. To claim the deduction, the individual is required to
- 8 have in the individual's possession a written statement from
- 9 the fire chief or other appropriate supervisor verifying that
- 10 the individual was a volunteer fire fighter or volunteer
- 11 emergency medical services provider for at least six months of
- 12 the tax year for which the deduction under paragraph "a" is
- 13 claimed.
- 14 Sec. 2. RETROACTIVE APPLICABILITY. This Act applies
- 15 retroactively to January 1, 2003, for tax years beginning on
- 16 or after that date.
- 17 EXPLANATION
- 18 This bill establishes a deduction when computing net income
- 19 for state income tax purposes in the amount of \$2,500 for an
- 20 individual who volunteers as an emergency medical services
- 21 provider or a fire fighter, or both, for at least six months
- 22 of the tax year.
- 23 The bill applies retroactively to tax years beginning on or
- 24 after January 1, 2003.
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
