- 1 Section 1. Section 157.1, Code 2003, is amended by adding 2 the following new subsections:
- 3 NEW SUBSECTION. 14A. "Press and curl" means a temporary
- 4 thermal straightening technique used for very curly hair which
- 5 does not utilize the application of chemicals and which allows
- 6 the hair's reversion to its natural state when shampooed.
- 7 NEW SUBSECTION. 14B. "Press and curl technician" means a
- 8 person who performs the practice of press and curl.
- 9 Sec. 2. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 157.5 PRESS AND CURL TECHNICIANS -- 10 AUTHORIZATION.
- 11 1. The department shall issue a license to practice press
- 12 and curl techniques to a person who submits proof of
- 13 successful completion of a course of training in a licensed
- 14 school of cosmetology arts and sciences, or a barber school
- 15 licensed pursuant to section 158.7, relating to proper care of
- 16 the hair. The course of training shall include application of
- 17 press and curl techniques pursuant to rules adopted by the
- 18 board. A press and curl technician licensed pursuant to this
- 19 section shall be authorized to practice press and curl
- 20 techniques without obtaining a cosmetology license or being
- 21 licensed under any other provision of this chapter or chapter
- 22 158.
- 23 2. The applicant shall pay a license fee as determined by
- 24 the board under section 147.80.
- 25 3. The rules of the board shall include a provision
- 26 whereby a license to practice press and curl techniques may be
- 27 issued by reciprocity or endorsement to a person who is
- 28 licensed in another state to practice press and curl
- 29 techniques.
- 30 EXPLANATION
- 31 This bill provides for licensure to perform the press and
- 32 curl hair straightening technique. The bill defines "press
- 33 and curl" as a temporary thermal straightening technique used
- 34 for very curly hair which does not utilize the application of
- 35 chemicals and which allows the hair's reversion to its natural

1 state when shampooed. The bill provides that the Iowa 2 department of public health shall issue a license to practice 3 press and curl techniques to a person submitting proof of 4 successful completion of a course of training in a licensed 5 school of cosmetology arts and sciences or licensed barber 6 school. The bill provides that the course of training shall 7 include specific instruction in the application of press and 8 curl techniques pursuant to rules adopted by the board of 9 cosmetology arts and sciences examiners. The bill provides 10 that a licensed press and curl technician shall be authorized 11 to practice the press and curl technique without being 12 licensed under any other provision of Code chapter 157, 13 relating to cosmetology, or Code chapter 158, relating to The bill provides for the payment of a license fee 14 barbering. 15 for reciprocity with other states, and for a penalty of a 16 serious misdemeanor pursuant to Code section 157.15. 17 18 19 20 21 22 23 24 25 26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33 34
