285.17 TRANSPORTATION FUNDING. 1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 2 Transportation services provided by a school district, 3 other than for reimbursement of nonpublic school pupil 4 transportation pursuant to section 285.2, shall be funded 5 pursuant to the district transportation levy established in 6 section 298.4A. A school district with an average 7 transportation cost exceeding the state average transportation 8 cost by one hundred fifty percent shall be eligible for 9 transportation assistance aid pursuant to section 257.31. 298.4A DISTRICT TRANSPORTATION 10 Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. 11 LEVY.

12 1. The board of directors of an eligible school district 13 may certify for levy by April 15 of a school year, a tax on 14 all taxable property in the school district for a district 15 transportation levy. A school district shall be eligible to 16 levy for transportation costs if the district's average 17 transportation cost exceeds one hundred seventy dollars per 18 pupil. The revenues from the tax levied in this section shall 19 be placed in the district transportation levy fund of the 20 school district. District transportation levy revenues shall 21 be expended for transportation costs incurred pursuant to 22 chapter 285 including, but not limited to, costs for the 23 following:

24 a. Transporting students.

25 b. Purchasing of transportation equipment.

26 c. Purchasing transportation services.

27 d. Leasing transportation equipment and lease-purchasing28 transportation equipment.

29 2. The amount certified for levy shall not include claims 30 for reimbursement of nonpublic school pupil transportation for 31 which funds are appropriated to the department of education 32 pursuant to section 285.2.

33 Sec. 3. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 298A.3A DISTRICT TRANSPORTATION 34 LEVY FUND.

35 The district transportation levy fund is a special revenue

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1 fund. A district transportation levy fund must be established 2 in any school corporation which levies the tax authorized 3 under section 298.4A.

EXPLANATION

This bill provides that transportation services provided by 5 6 a school district pursuant to Code chapter 285 shall be funded 7 by a district transportation levy. The bill provides that a 8 school district shall be eligible to levy for transportation 9 costs if the district's average transportation cost exceeds 10 \$170 per pupil. The bill provides that revenue from the levy 11 shall be placed in a district transportation levy fund of the 12 school district, and expended for transporting students, 13 purchasing transportation equipment, purchasing transportation 14 services, and leasing or lease-purchasing transportation 15 equipment. The bill provides that the amount certified for 16 levy shall not include reimbursement claims for nonpublic 17 school pupil transportation for which funds are appropriated 18 to the department of education pursuant to Code section 285.2. 19 The bill also provides that a school district with an average 20 transportation cost exceeding the state average transportation 21 cost by 150 percent shall remain eligible for transportation 22 assistance aid pursuant to Code section 257.31.

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
