A BILL FOR

1 An Act establishing a special breast cancer awareness motor
2 vehicle registration plate and appropriating fees from such
3 plates for breast cancer screening.

1 Section 1. Section 321.34, Code 2003, is amended by adding
2 the following new subsection:

3 NEW SUBSECTION. 23. BREAST CANCER AWARENESS PLATES.

4 a. Upon application and payment of the proper fees, the
5 director may issue breast cancer awareness plates to an owner
6 of a motor vehicle referred to in subsection 12.

7 b. Breast cancer awareness plates shall contain an image
8 of a pink ribbon and shall be designed by the department in
9 consultation with the Susan G. Komen foundation.

10 c. The special fee for letter number designated breast
11 cancer awareness plates is thirty-five dollars. The fee for
12 personalized breast cancer awareness plates is twenty-five
13 dollars, which shall be paid in addition to the special breast
14 cancer awareness fee of thirty-five dollars. The fees
15 collected by the director under this subsection shall be paid
16 monthly to the treasurer of state and credited to the road use
17 tax fund. Notwithstanding section 423.24, and prior to the
18 crediting of revenues to the road use tax fund under section
19 423.24, subsection 1, paragraph "b", the treasurer of state
20 shall transfer monthly from those revenues to the Iowa
21 department of public health the amount of the special fees
22 collected in the previous month for the breast cancer
23 awareness plates and such funds are appropriated to the Iowa
24 department of public health. The Iowa department of public
25 health shall distribute one hundred percent of the funds
26 received monthly in the form of grants to support breast
27 cancer screenings for both men and women who meet eligibility
28 requirements like those established by the Susan G. Komen
29 foundation. In the awarding of grants, the Iowa department of
30 public health shall give first consideration to affiliates of
31 the Susan G. Komen foundation and similar nonprofit
32 organizations providing for breast cancer screenings at no
33 cost in Iowa. Notwithstanding section 8.33, moneys
34 transferred under this subsection shall not revert to the
35 general fund of the state.

1 d. Upon receipt of the special registration plates, the
2 applicant shall surrender the current registration receipt and
3 plates to the county treasurer. The county treasurer shall
4 validate the special registration plates in the same manner as
5 regular registration plates are validated under this section.
6 The annual special breast cancer awareness fee for letter
7 number designated plates is ten dollars, which shall be paid
8 in addition to the regular annual registration fee. The
9 annual special fee for personalized breast cancer awareness
10 plates is five dollars, which shall be paid in addition to the
11 annual special breast cancer awareness fee and the regular
12 annual registration fee. The annual special breast cancer
13 awareness fee shall be credited and transferred as provided
14 under paragraph "c".

15 EXPLANATION

16 This bill establishes a special breast cancer awareness
17 motor vehicle registration plate to be issued by the state
18 department of transportation. The plate will bear a processed
19 emblem with an image of a pink ribbon signifying breast cancer
20 awareness. The special fee for initial issuance of the plate
21 is \$35 for letter number designated plates and \$60 for
22 personalized plates. The annual special fee, to be paid in
23 addition to the regular annual registration fee, is \$10 for
24 letter number designated plates and \$15 for personalized
25 plates.

26 The special fees from breast cancer awareness plates are
27 appropriated to the Iowa department of public health. The
28 department shall distribute 100 percent of the funds in the
29 form of grants to Iowa affiliates of the Susan G. Komen
30 foundation or similar nonprofit organizations operating in
31 Iowa to be used for breast cancer screening for men and women
32 who meet eligibility requirements like those established by
33 the Komen foundation.
