- 1 Section 1. Section 321.34, Code 2003, is amended by adding
- 2 the following new subsection:
- 3 NEW SUBSECTION. 23. BREAST CANCER AWARENESS PLATES.
- 4 a. Upon application and payment of the proper fees, the
- 5 director may issue breast cancer awareness plates to an owner
- 6 of a motor vehicle referred to in subsection 12.
- 7 b. Breast cancer awareness plates shall contain an image
- 8 of a pink ribbon and shall be designed by the department in
- 9 consultation with the Susan G. Komen foundation.
- 10 c. The special fee for letter number designated breast
- ll cancer awareness plates is thirty-five dollars. The fee for
- 12 personalized breast cancer awareness plates is twenty-five
- 13 dollars, which shall be paid in addition to the special breast
- 14 cancer awareness fee of thirty-five dollars. The fees
- 15 collected by the director under this subsection shall be paid
- 16 monthly to the treasurer of state and credited to the road use
- 17 tax fund. Notwithstanding section 423.24, and prior to the
- 18 crediting of revenues to the road use tax fund under section
- 19 423.24, subsection 1, paragraph "b", the treasurer of state
- 20 shall transfer monthly from those revenues to the Iowa
- 21 department of public health the amount of the special fees
- 22 collected in the previous month for the breast cancer
- 23 awareness plates and such funds are appropriated to the Iowa
- 24 department of public health. The Iowa department of public
- 25 health shall distribute one hundred percent of the funds
- 26 received monthly in the form of grants to support breast
- 27 cancer screenings for both men and women who meet eligibility
- 28 requirements like those established by the Susan G. Komen
- 29 foundation. In the awarding of grants, the Iowa department of
- 30 public health shall give first consideration to affiliates of
- 31 the Susan G. Komen foundation and similar nonprofit
- 32 organizations providing for breast cancer screenings at no
- 33 cost in Iowa. Notwithstanding section 8.33, moneys
- 34 transferred under this subsection shall not revert to the
- 35 general fund of the state.

d. Upon receipt of the special registration plates, the applicant shall surrender the current registration receipt and plates to the county treasurer. The county treasurer shall validate the special registration plates in the same manner as regular registration plates are validated under this section. The annual special breast cancer awareness fee for letter number designated plates is ten dollars, which shall be paid in addition to the regular annual registration fee. The annual special fee for personalized breast cancer awareness plates is five dollars, which shall be paid in addition to the annual special breast cancer awareness fee and the regular annual registration fee. The annual special breast cancer awareness fee shall be credited and transferred as provided under paragraph "c".

EXPLANATION

This bill establishes a special breast cancer awareness
notor vehicle registration plate to be issued by the state
department of transportation. The plate will bear a processed
emblem with an image of a pink ribbon signifying breast cancer
awareness. The special fee for initial issuance of the plate
is \$35 for letter number designated plates and \$60 for
personalized plates. The annual special fee, to be paid in
addition to the regular annual registration fee, is \$10 for
tetter number designated plates and \$15 for personalized
plates.

The special fees from breast cancer awareness plates are appropriated to the Iowa department of public health. The department shall distribute 100 percent of the funds in the form of grants to Iowa affiliates of the Susan G. Komen foundation or similar nonprofit organizations operating in Iowa to be used for breast cancer screening for men and women who meet eligibility requirements like those established by the Komen foundation.
