1 Section 1. Section 321.384, Code 2003, is amended to read 2 as follows:

3 321.384 WHEN LIGHTED LAMPS REQUIRED.

1. Every <u>A</u> motor vehicle <u>operated</u> upon a highway within <u>5 the this state</u>, <u>shall display lighted headlamps as provided in</u> <u>6 section 321.415</u> at any time from sunset to sunrise, <u>at any</u> <u>7 time the motor vehicle's windshield wipers are in continuous</u> <u>8 operation</u>, and at such other times when conditions such as <u>9 fog</u>, snow, sleet, or rain provide insufficient lighting to 10 render clearly discernible persons and vehicles on the highway <u>11 at a distance of five hundred feet ahead</u>, <u>shall-display</u> <u>12 lighted-head-lamps-as-provided-in-section-321.4157</u> subject to <u>13 exceptions with respect to parked vehicles as-hereinafter</u> <u>14 stated under this chapter</u>.

15 2. Whenever <u>A</u> requirement is-hereinafter-declared-as-to 16 regarding the distance from which certain lamps and devices 17 shall render objects visible or within which such lamps or 18 devices shall be visible;-said-provisions shall apply during 19 the times stated in subsection 1 of-this-section upon a 20 straight level unlighted highway under normal atmospheric 21 conditions unless a different time or condition is expressly 22 stated.

23 Sec. 2. WARNING CITATIONS. During the first six months 24 following the effective date of this Act, peace officers shall 25 issue only warning citations for the following:

26 1. Motor vehicles not displaying lighted headlamps at any 27 time the motor vehicle's windshield wipers are in continuous 28 operation as required by section 321.384, subsection 1, as 29 amended in this Act.

2. Persons violating other lighting provisions in chapter 31 321 which require the use of certain lights at any time the 32 motor vehicle's windshield wipers are in continuous operation 33 as required by section 321.384, subsection 1, as amended in 34 this Act.

This bill amends Code section 321.384 by requiring a motor 2 vehicle to display lighted headlights at any time when the 3 vehicle's wipers are in continuous operation. Due to current 4 Code references to Code section 321.384, the bill also 5 requires the use of certain lights on other types of vehicles 6 while the vehicle's wipers are in operation. A violation of 7 these provisions is a simple misdemeanor punishable by a 8 scheduled fine of \$20 under Code section 805.8A. The bill 9 also provides that during the first six months following 10 enactment, violations of these provisions will only result in 11 warning citations. LSB 2745YH 80
