## A BILL FOR

1	An	Act relating to state and local funding for the costs of
2		providing educational services to children residing in
3		psychiatric medical institutions for children and mental
4		health institutes operated by the state, and providing
5		effective date and retroactive applicability provisions.
6	BE	IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 282.27, Code 2003, is amended to read
- 2 as follows:
- 3 282.27 CHILDREN LIVING IN PSYCHIATRIC HOSPITALS OR
- 4 INSTITUTIONS -- PAYMENT.
- 5 l. The public school district in which is located a
- 6 psychiatric unit of a hospital licensed under chapter 135B or
- 7 a psychiatric medical institution for children licensed under
- 8 chapter 135H, which is not operated by the state, shall be
- 9 responsible for the provision of educational services to
- 10 children residing in the unit or institution. Children
- ll residing in the unit or institution shall be included in the
- 12 basic enrollment of their districts of residence, as defined
- 13 in section 282.31, subsection 4.
- 14 The board of directors of each district of residence shall
- 15 pay to the school district in which is located such
- 16 psychiatric unit or institution, for the provision of
- 17 educational services to the child, a portion of the district
- 18 of residence's district cost per pupil for each of such
- 19 children based upon the proportion that the time each child is
- 20 provided educational services while in such unit or
- 21 institution is to the total time for which the child is
- 22 provided educational services during a normal school year.
- 23 2. a. The department of human services shall provide
- 24 educational services to children residing in a psychiatric
- 25 medical institution for children licensed under chapter 135H
- 26 and operated by the state and to children residing in a mental
- 27 health institute under the jurisdiction of the director of
- 28 human services in accordance with section 218.1, subsections 3
- 29 and 5. However, for the budget year beginning July 1, 2002,
- 30 and for each succeeding budget year, the children residing in
- 31 the institutions shall be included in the basic enrollment of
- 32 their districts of residence, as defined in section 282.31,
- 33 subsection 4.
- b. The board of directors of each district of residence
- 35 shall pay to the psychiatric medical institution for children

- 1 or the mental health institute providing educational services
- 2 to a child included in the basic enrollment of the district,
- 3 in accordance with paragraph "a", a portion of the district of
- 4 residence's district cost per pupil for each of such children
- 5 based upon the proportion that the time each child is provided
- 6 educational services while residing in the institution or
- 7 institute is to the total time for which the child is provided
- 8 educational services during the normal school year.
- 9 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE AND RETROACTIVE APPLICABILITY.
- 10 This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, takes effect
- 11 upon enactment and applies retroactively to the school budget
- 12 year beginning July 1, 2002.
- 13 EXPLANATION
- 14 This bill requires that children who reside in the Toledo
- 15 and Eldora psychiatric medical institutions for children and
- 16 children who reside in the Cherokee and Independence mental
- 17 health institutes, for the budget year beginning July 1, 2002,
- 18 and for each succeeding budget year, be included in the basic
- 19 enrollment of their school districts of residence.
- 20 Under the bill, the board of directors of each school
- 21 district of residence must pay the institution or institute
- 22 providing educational services to a child included in the
- 23 district's basic enrollment, who receives educational services
- 24 from the institution or institute, a portion of the district
- 25 of residence's district cost per pupil for the child based
- 26 upon the proportion that the time the child is provided
- 27 educational services while residing in the institution or
- 28 institute is to the total time for which the child is provided
- 29 educational services during the normal school year.
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
