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1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 390.8 ADDITIONAL MUNICIPAL
2 POWERS.

3 In addition to the powers conferred upon a city elsewhere 4 in this chapter, a city may contract with, enter into an 5 agreement with, or acquire an equity interest in a business 6 corporation, limited liability company, or similar business 7 entity for any of the following purposes:

8 1. Participating with a private power company, electric 9 cooperative, or other independent entity functioning as a 10 regional transmission organization, independent system 11 operator, independent transmission company, or independent 12 transmission operator in a manner approved by the federal 13 energy regulatory commission under one or more provisions of 14 the Federal Power Act or comparable provisions of the laws of 15 this or any other state.

16 2. Implementing the offering of nondiscriminatory, open-17 access tariffs for the use of electric transmission or 18 distribution facilities in response to or in anticipation of 19 rules or orders by the United States under the Federal Power 20 Act or comparable provisions of the laws of this or any other 21 state.

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EXPLANATION

This bill adds a new section to Code chapter 390, relating to joint electrical utilities. New Code section 390.8 provides that a city may enter into contracts or agreements with, or acquire equity interests in a business entity, for the purpose of participating in a regional or independent transmission organization approved by the federal energy regulatory commission, or for implementing the offering of open-access tariffs for transmission of distribution facilities.

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
