A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the marketing of motor vehicle fuel and making2 penalties applicable.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 214A.1, Code 2003, is amended by adding
- 2 the following new subsections:
- 3 NEW SUBSECTION. OA. "Advertise" means to present a
- 4 commercial message in any medium including but not limited to
- 5 print, radio, television, sign, display, label, tag, or
- 6 articulation.
- 7 NEW SUBSECTION. 2A. "Motor vehicle fuel pump" or "pump"
- 8 means a motor vehicle fuel pump as defined in section 214.1.
- 9 Sec. 2. Section 214A.3, Code 2003, is amended to read as
- 10 follows:
- 11 214A.3 FALSE REPRESENTATIONS.
- 12 <u>l.</u> A person for-purposes-of-selling who sells motor
- 13 vehicle fuel or an oxygenate octane enhancer shall not falsely
- 14 represent do any of the following:
- 15 a. Falsely advertise the quality or kind of any the motor
- 16 vehicle fuel or oxygenate octane enhancer. or-add
- b. Add coloring matter thereto to the motor vehicle fuel
- 18 or oxygenate octane enhancer for the purpose of misleading the
- 19 public as to its quality.
- 20 2. A retail dealer shall not advertise the sale of motor
- 21 vehicle fuel which is available at a motor vehicle fuel pump
- 22 owned or controlled by the retail dealer, if the retail dealer
- 23 limits the quantity of the motor vehicle fuel which may be
- 24 purchased at the pump at the advertised price. However,
- 25 nothing in this subsection prevents a retail dealer from
- 26 limiting the period for sale of motor vehicle fuel at a
- 27 particular price or requires the retail dealer to obtain
- 28 additional motor vehicle fuel for sale at that price.
- 29 EXPLANATION
- 30 This bill amends Code chapter 214A which provides for the
- 31 sale of motor vehicle fuel at retail (such as gasoline sold at
- 32 service stations). Under the Code chapter, a retail dealer is
- 33 the person who sells or offers motor vehicle fuel for sale to
- 34 the public. The bill prohibits a retail dealer from
- 35 advertising the sale of motor vehicle fuel sold at service

1 stations owned or controlled by the dealer, if the retail
 2 dealer limits the amount that may be purchased at the
 3 advertised price. However, it does not prevent the retail
 4 dealer from limiting the period for sale of motor vehicle fuel
 5 at a particular price. It also does not require the retail
 6 dealer to obtain additional motor vehicle fuel for sale at
 7 that price.
      Under Code section 214A.11, a retail dealer who violates a
9 provision of the Code chapter is guilty of a simple
10 misdemeanor. A simple misdemeanor is punishable by
11 confinement for no more than 30 days or a fine of at least $50
12 but not more than $500 or by both.
