5 Sec. 2. Section 331.608, Code 2003, is amended by adding 6 the following new subsection:

7 <u>NEW SUBSECTION</u>. 5A. Unless otherwise provided by the 8 person who requested the recording of a record under this 9 section, notwithstanding section 22.2, subsection 1, such 10 record shall be confidential and shall not be made available 11 for examination or copying except as follows:

12 a. To the person who is the subject of the record, to a 13 member of that person's immediate family, or to that person's 14 agent or representative duly authorized in writing.

b. To a person requesting to examine or copy a record when the event that resulted in the record being made occurred more than seventy-five years prior to the request.

18 c. When otherwise ordered by a court of competent 19 jurisdiction.

20 d. When otherwise required by a department or agency of 21 the federal or state government or a political subdivision 22 thereof.

## EXPLANATION

This bill provides that military personnel records of veterans, including records of discharges and reports of separation, that are maintained by the county recorder are confidential records, notwithstanding Code section 22.2, subsection 1. The bill provides that the records shall not be available for examination and copying except by a person who is the subject of the record, that person's immediate family, or that person's duly authorized agent or representative, by a person requesting to examine or copy a record of an event cocurring more than 75 years prior to the request, when when required by a department or agency of the state or
