Section 1. Section 321G.1, subsection 1, unnumbered 2 paragraph 1, Code 2003, is amended to read as follows: "All-terrain vehicle" means a motorized flotation-tire 4 vehicle with not less than three low pressure tires, but not 5 more than six low pressure tires, or a two-wheeled off-road 6 motorcycle, that is limited in engine displacement to less 7 than eight hundred cubic centimeters and in total dry weight 8 to less than seven eight hundred fifty pounds and that has a 9 seat or saddle designed to be straddled by the operator and 10 handlebars for steering control. 11 Sec. 2. Section 321G.13, subsection 3, Code 2003, is 12 amended to read as follows: 13 A person shall not operate an all-terrain vehicle white 14 carrying-a-passenger with more persons on the vehicle than it 15 was designed to carry. 16 **EXPLANATION** 17 This bill prohibits the operation of an all-terrain vehicle 18 with more persons on the vehicle than it was designed to 19 carry. Current law does not allow operation of an all-terrain 20 vehicle with a passenger on board, regardless of the vehicle's 21 design.
