Section 1. QUALITY SERVICE REVIEW PILOT PROJECT. 2 appropriated from the general fund of the state to the 3 department of human services for the fiscal year beginning 4 July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2004, the following amount, 5 or so much thereof as is necessary, to be used for the purpose 6 designated: For a grant to a community empowerment area board located 8 in a county with a population between 103,000 and 105,000 in 9 the latest decennial census to be used to implement a pilot 10 project in accordance with this section: 245,000 12 The grant shall be used over a three-year period to develop 13 a statewide model for a multiagency quality service review 14 process for the highest-cost child cases within the juvenile 15 justice, education, and child welfare systems. The design 16 team for the project shall consist of approximately nine to 12 17 persons representative of persons and agencies in the area 18 involved with special education, mental health, juvenile 19 court, and child welfare systems. The grant shall be used for 20 training, technical assistance, and administrative components 21 of the project. The grantee shall provide regular reports to 22 the department concerning status, findings, and 23 recommendations. 24 **EXPLANATION** This bill provides an appropriation to the department of 25 26 human services for a grant to implement a multiagency quality 27 service review pilot project directed to highest-cost child 28 cases in the juvenile justice, education, and child welfare 29 systems. The grant is to be made to a community empowerment 30 area board located in a county with a population between 31 103,000 and 105,000. The pilot project design team is to 32 include persons representative of persons and agencies in the 33 area involved with the three systems as well as the mental 34 health system. The pilot project is to be conducted over a 35 three-year period.
