5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:	
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1 Section 1. Section 514C.18, subsection 1, paragraph b, 2 subparagraph (2), unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 2003, is 3 amended to read as follows: The diabetic self-management training and education program 4 5 is certified by the American diabetes association or the Iowa 6 department of public health. The department shall follow the 7 standards set forth by the American diabetes association for 8 certification and renewal of the diabetes self-management 9 programs. The department shall consult with the American 10 diabetes association, Iowa affiliate, in developing the ll standards for certification of diabetes education programs as 12 follows: Sec. 2. Section 514C.18, subsection 1, paragraph b, 13 14 subparagraph (2), subparagraph subdivision (a), part (ii), 15 Code 2003, is amended to read as follows: (ii) Poor glycemic control as evidenced by a glycosylated 16 17 hemoglobin of nine eight and five-tenths or more in the ninety 18 days before attending the training. Section 514C.18, subsection 1, paragraph b, 19 Sec. 3. 20 subparagraph (2), subparagraph subdivision (b), Code 2003, is 21 amended to read as follows: 22 (b) An individual who receives the initial training shall 23 be eligible for a single follow-up training session of up to 24 one-hour two hours each year. Sec. 4. Section 514C.18, subsection 1, Code 2003, is 25 26 amended by adding the following new paragraph: NEW PARAGRAPH. c. Medications approved by the United 27 28 States food and drug administration for the control of blood 29 sugar levels, including insulin and oral agents, prescribed by 30 the patient's physician. EXPLANATION 31 This bill amends Code section 514C.18, relating to 32 33 insurance coverage for diabetes. The bill provides that a 34 policy or contract providing for third-party payment or 35 prepayment of health or medical expenses shall provide

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
