- 1 Section 1. Section 708.3A, subsections 1 through 4, Code
- 2 2003, are amended to read as follows:
- A person who commits an assault, as defined in section
- 4 708.1, against a peace officer, jailer, correctional staff,
- 5 health care provider, employee of a juvenile placement
- 6 facility, or fire fighter, whether paid or volunteer, with the
- 7 knowledge that the person against whom the assault is
- 8 committed is a peace officer, jailer, correctional staff,
- 9 health care provider, employee of a juvenile placement
- 10 facility, or fire fighter and with the intent to inflict a
- ll serious injury upon the peace officer, jailer, correctional
- 12 staff, health care provider, employee of a juvenile placement
- 13 facility, or fire fighter, is guilty of a class "D" felony.
- 14 2. A person who commits an assault, as defined in section
- 15 708.1, against a peace officer, jailer, correctional staff,
- 16 health care provider, employee of a juvenile placement
- 17 facility, or fire fighter, whether paid or volunteer, who
- 18 knows that the person against whom the assault is committed is
- 19 a peace officer, jailer, correctional staff, health care
- 20 provider, employee of a juvenile placement facility, or fire
- 21 fighter and who uses or displays a dangerous weapon in
- 22 connection with the assault, is guilty of a class "D" felony.
- 23 3. A person who commits an assault, as defined in section
- 24 708.1, against a peace officer, jailer, correctional staff,
- 25 health care provider, employee of a juvenile placement
- 26 facility, or fire fighter, whether paid or volunteer, who
- 27 knows that the person against whom the assault is committed is
- 28 a peace officer, jailer, correctional staff, health care
- 29 provider, employee of a juvenile placement facility, or fire
- 30 fighter, and who causes bodily injury or mental illness, is
- 31 guilty of an aggravated misdemeanor.
- 32 4. Any other assault, as defined in section 708.1,
- 33 committed against a peace officer, jailer, correctional staff,
- 34 health care provider, employee of a juvenile placement
- 35 facility, or fire fighter, whether paid or volunteer, by a

- 1 person who knows that the person against whom the assault is

- 5 Sec. 2. Section 708.3A, Code 2003, is amended by adding
- 6 the following new subsection:
- 7 NEW SUBSECTION. 8. As used in this section, "employee of
- 8 a juvenile placement facility" means an employee of a juvenile
- 9 placement facility listed in section 709.16. A person who
- 10 commits an assault under this section against an employee of a
- 11 juvenile placement facility is presumed to know that the
- 12 person against whom the assault is committed is an employee of
- 13 a juvenile placement facility.
- 14 EXPLANATION
- 15 This bill amends Code section 708.3A relating to an assault
- 16 on a peace officer, jailer, correctional staff, health care
- 17 provider, or fire fighter. The bill adds an employee of a
- 18 juvenile placement facility to the list of occupations covered
- 19 under Code section 708.3A. The bill effectively increases the
- 20 penalty for most assaults on an employee of a juvenile
- 21 placement facility. However, the bill does not increase the
- 22 penalty for a class "D" felony assault.
- 23 The bill provides that if a person assaults an employee of
- 24 a juvenile placement facility with the intent to inflict
- 25 serious injury or uses or displays a dangerous weapon in
- 26 connection with the assault, that person commits a class "D"
- 27 felony. If a person assaults an employee of a juvenile
- 28 placement facility, and causes bodily injury or mental
- 29 illness, that person commits an aggravated misdemeanor and if
- 30 the person commits any other type of assault, that person
- 31 commits a serious misdemeanor.
- 32 The bill defines "an employee of a juvenile placement
- 33 facility" to mean an employee of a juvenile placement facility
- 34 listed in Code section 709.16.
- 35 A serious misdemeanor is punishable by confinement for no

1 more than one year and a fine of at least $250 but not more
2 than $1,500. An aggravated misdemeanor is punishable by
3 confinement for no more than two years and a fine of at least
4 $500 but not more than $5,000. A class "D" felony is
5 punishable by confinement for no more than five years and a
6 fine of at least $750 but not more than $7,500.
