1 Section 1. Section 280.12, subsection 2, Code 2003, is  
2 amended by adding the following new paragraph:

3 NEW PARAGRAPH. f. Foreign language needs at the  
4 elementary school level.

5 EXPLANATION

6 This bill requires a school district to consider its school  
7 improvement advisory committee's recommendations on the  
8 foreign language needs at the elementary school level.

9 Each school board and accredited nonpublic school is  
10 required under the Code to appoint a school improvement  
11 advisory committee to make recommendations to the board or  
12 authorities. The committee consists of students, parents,  
13 teachers, administrators, and representatives from the local  
14 community.
