2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- Section 1. Section 279.7A, Code 2003, is amended to read

- 3 279.7A INTEREST IN PUBLIC CONTRACTS PROHIBITED --
- 4 EXCEPTIONS.
- 5 A member of the board of directors of a school corporation
- 6 shall not have an interest, direct or indirect, in a contract
- 7 for the purchase of goods, including materials and profits,
- 8 and the performance of services for the director's school
- 9 corporation. A contract entered into in violation of this
- 10 section is void. This section does not apply to contracts for
- 11 the purchase of goods or services which benefit a director, or
- 12 to compensation for part-time or temporary employment which

10 or indirect, in certain contracts if the contracts are made by
11 competitive bid, publicly invited and opened, or if the
12 remuneration of employment for the person is not directly
13 affected as a result of the contract and the duties of the
14 person's employment do not directly involve the procurement or
15 preparation of any part of the contract.
      The conflict of interest provisions also do not apply to

17 contracts in which a member of a school board, or a city or
18 county officer or employee has a direct or indirect interest,
19 when the contracts are bonds, notes, or other obligations of
