- Notwithstanding any provision of law or rule relating to

- 28 technology-related goods or services supplied by Iowa software

- 32 bid notices for distribution to the Iowa software and

- 34 department of economic development if the director releases a
- 35 solicitation for bids for procurement of software or

- 2 shall be provided to the web page manager and by electronic
- 3 mail to any Iowa software and information technology industry
