- Section 1. ENVIRONMENT FIRST FUND. There is appropriated 1 2 from the cash reserve fund to the environment first fund for 3 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 4 2003, the following amount: 5 \$ 16,555,000 Sec. 2. CASH RESERVE FUND. 1. Notwithstanding section 8.33 and the nonreversion 8 provision in 2002 Iowa Acts, chapter 1173, section 22, 9 subsection 1, moneys in the environment first fund remaining 10 unencumbered or unobligated at the end of the fiscal year 11 beginning July 1, 2002, shall be transferred to the cash 12 reserve fund. 2. Notwithstanding subsection 1, the total amount 14 transferred pursuant to subsection 1 shall not exceed 15 \$16,555,000. The transfer to the cash reserve fund specified 16 in subsection 1 shall not apply to any unencumbered or 17 unobligated moneys that are not to revert as provided in 2002 18 Iowa Acts, chapter 1173, section 22, subsection 2. Sec. 3. CASH RESERVE FUND. If the United States supreme 20 court ruling is decided on or after July 1, 2003, in favor of 21 the state's taxation of the adjusted gross revenues from 22 gambling games at racetrack enclosures, and results in 23 additional tax revenues being deposited into the rebuild Iowa 24 infrastructure fund, an amount of the additional tax revenues 25 equal to the difference between \$16,555,000 and the amount 26 transferred to the cash reserve fund pursuant to section 2 of
- 28 Sec. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of

27 this Act shall be transferred to the cash reserve fund.

- 30 EXPLANATION
- 31 This bill appropriates \$16,555,000 from the cash reserve
- 32 fund to the environment first fund for FY 2002-2003. The bill
- 33 provides that any moneys that are not obligated in the
- 34 environment first fund at the end of FY 2002-2003 are to be
- 35 transferred to the cash reserve fund, except for unobligated

1 moneys for soil conservation practices. In addition, if the 2 United States supreme court rules in favor of the legality of 3 Iowa's tax on the gross receipts from slot machines at the 4 racetracks then any additional tax revenues deposited into the 5 rebuild Iowa infrastructure fund are to be transferred to the 6 cash reserve fund in an amount equal to \$16,555,000 less the 7 amount transferred from the environment first fund. The bill takes effect upon enactment.
