6 one of the quarterly meetings shall be held during the regular
7 session of the general assembly.

8 b. Administrative support and other assistance for the
9 conference shall be provided by the department of management
10 and by other departments and agencies as deemed appropriate by
11 the conference.

12 c. The conference may retain an organization to serve as
13 an additional source of information as deemed appropriate by
14 the conference. In selecting an organization, the conference
15 shall give consideration to both public and private
16 organizations. If an organization is retained, the conference
17 shall review the arrangement with the organization at least
18 every four years.

19 EXPLANATION

20 This bill relates to the responsibilities and authority of
21 the revenue estimating conference.

22 The bill requires at least one of the conference's
23 quarterly meetings to be held during the regular session of
24 the general assembly.

25 The department of management, other departments of the
26 executive branch, and agencies are required to provide
27 administrative support and other assistance as deemed
28 appropriate by the conference. In addition, the conference is
29 authorized to retain an organization to serve as an additional
30 source of information to the conference and shall consider
31 both public and private organizations in making a selection.
32 If an organization is retained, the arrangement with the
33 organization must be reviewed as least every four years.

9 use of estimates agreed to by the conference, an estimate
10 agreed to by the conference shall be used by the three
11 branches of state government for the other budgeting
12 activities of the branches.

13 c. Administrative support and other assistance for the
14 conference shall be provided by the department of management
15 and by other departments and agencies as deemed appropriate by
16 the conference.

17 d. The conference may retain an organization to serve as
18 an additional source of information as deemed appropriate by
19 the conference. In selecting an organization, the conference
20 shall give consideration to both public and private
21 organizations. If an organization is retained, the conference
22 shall review the arrangement with the organization at least
23 every four years.

24 EXPLANATION

25 This bill relates to the responsibilities and authority of
26 the revenue estimating conference.

27 The bill requires at least one of the conference's
28 quarterly meetings to be held during the regular session of
29 the general assembly. In addition to the requirements in
30 current law for using estimates agreed to by the conference,
31 the bill requires the estimates to be used in the other
32 budgeting activities of the three branches of state
33 government.

34 The department of management, other departments of the
35 executive branch, and agencies are required to provide

1 administrative support and other assistance as deemed
2 appropriate by the conference. In addition, the conference is
3 authorized to retain an organization to serve as an additional
4 source of information to the conference and shall consider
5 both public and private organizations in making a selection.
6 If an organization is retained, the arrangement with the
7 organization must be reviewed as least every four years.
