- 1 Section 1. Section 99B.11, subsection 2, paragraph c, Code
- 2 2003, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 c. Contests or exhibitions of cooking, horticulture,
- 4 livestock, poultry, fish or other animals, artwork, hobbywork
- 5 or craftwork, except those prohibited by section 725-11
- 6 717D.2.

- 14 1. A Except as provided in subsection 2, a person shall

- 17 1. a. Own-or-operate Owns or operates an establishment
- 18 located in this state in which a contest event occurs or is to

- 20 2. b. Act Acts as a promoter of a contest event,

6 EXPLANATION

- 7 BACKGROUND. The general assembly enacted Senate File 2268
- 8 (2002 Iowa Acts, ch. 1130), which in part created new Code
- 9 chapter 717D prohibiting activities referred to as "contest
- 10 events" in which certain animals are engaged in fighting
- 11 sports (a bull, bear, chicken, or dog). A person violating a
- 12 provision in new Code chapter 717D is guilty of a serious
- 13 misdemeanor.
- 14 PROVISIONS OF THE BILL. This bill increases the criminal
- 15 penalty applicable to a person who owns or operates an
- 16 establishment located in this state in which a contest event
- 17 occurs or is to occur or who acts as a promoter of a contest
- 18 event. Under the bill, the person is guilty of a class "D"
- 19 felony. A class "D" felony is punishable by confinement for
- 20 no more than five years and a fine of at least \$750 but not
- 21 more than \$7,500.
- The bill repeals Code section 725.11, which first appeared
- 23 in the Code of 1873, prohibiting animal contests. A person
- 24 who commits a violation of that section is guilty of a serious
- 25 misdemeanor.
