9 registration shall not be effective until the registrant
10 reaches the age of eighteen.
     Sec. 2. Section 48A.26, subsection 7, Code 2003, is

         When a person who is at least seventeen and-one-half

14 years of age but less than eighteen years of age registers to
15 vote, the commissioner shall maintain a record of the
16 registration so as to clearly indicate that it will not take
17 effect until the registrant's eighteenth birthday and that the
18 person is registered and qualifies to vote at any election
