      This bill amends Code section 514C.4, relating to mandated

22 insurance coverage for mammography. The bill adds required
23 coverage for physician-recommended mammograms every six months
24 for women with a family history of breast cancer.
25 also deletes an outdated 1989 date reference in Code language
26 requiring the insurance commissioner to adopt administrative
27 rules to administer the Code section.
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
