6	WHEREAS, many health care providers are facing
7	nursing shortages, resulting in nurses working
8	excessive overtime and research indicates there are
9	important linkages between nurse staffing levels and
10	adverse patient outcomes; and
11	WHEREAS, mandatory overtime practices which compel
12	or force nurses to work hours beyond agreed-upon
13	assignments by using threats of discrimination,
14	dismissal, licensure discipline, or other coercive
15	sanctions have been addressed in laws enacted in other
16	states; NOW THEREFORE,
17	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES,
18	That the government oversight committee of the house
19	of representatives is requested to study nurse
20	staffing levels and mandatory overtime practices
21	involving nurses during the 2003 legislative interim
22	and to make recommendations for legislative action by
23	the Eightieth General Assembly, 2004 Regular Session.
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
