HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 341 HOFFMAN 2 BY 3 A Resolution honoring Mr. Roger Rusch and Mrs. Connie Rusch for their acts of heroism in saving the lives 4 of Aleshea Cogdill and Ashley Neddermeyer. 5 WHEREAS, On June 8, 2002, a single-car accident 6 7 occurred near the farm home of Mr. Rusch and the now 8 deceased Mrs. Rusch, west of the town of Schleswig, in 9 Crawford County, Iowa; and WHEREAS, having heard the accident, Mr. and Mrs. 10 11 Rusch endangered their own lives by attempting to 12 extinguish the burning car and removing Ashley 13 Neddermeyer by breaking the back window when the doors 14 to the burning vehicle would not open; and WHEREAS, Mr. Rusch further endangered himself by 15 16 returning to the burning car and removing the 17 unconscious Aleshea Cogdill also through the back 18 window of the car; and WHEREAS, Mr. and Mrs. Rusch stayed with and 19 20 ministered to the young girls until emergency rescue 21 units arrived; NOW THEREFORE, 22 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, 23 That Mrs. Connie Rusch be honored posthumously and 24 remembered by the citizens of the State of Iowa for 25 her remarkable courage and heroism without regard to 26 her own personal safety; and 27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That Mr. Roger Rusch be 28 honored and commended by the House of Representatives 29 for his quick thinking, his courage, and his heroism, 30 without regard to his own personal safety, by pulling
